Week 11: Rescue LIFE James and Betty Robison Jay Richards #2

In the studio

BETTY: Welcome to *LIFE Today*. Thank you so much for joining us. I'm Betty Robison; this is my husband, James. We've got a special guest with us today, Jay Richards. He has been a friend of ours for a long time. He and James wrote a book many years ago called *Indivisible*. Now they've come back with a revision of it. It is even better. I guarantee you, I've started into it. You won't want to put it down except maybe to pause a second on each chapter and let God speak to you through it. Because you'll want to get it deep down in your heart—real truth. So welcome James and Jay Richards.

JAMES: Yeah, and Jay, we both point out it is not really a revision because we kind of started to make it where we wanted to step it down for a higher academic level. It was hard for some people because it was written by very, very, very highly educated people who I had to work with and encourage them. But I needed their brilliance to get what we had to do. But everybody began to say this is too important. Everybody has got to get it. So we put it down at a level, you start about junior high school, and everybody all the way through their P.H.D.'s gets this. And they are.

Yesterday, Jay—and by the way, to me, you are a mountain mover. And you and I, would you agree we've been a good team?

JAY: Yeah! It's amazing and improbable from the very beginning. But it's been amazing. I think it's been 13-14 years. Seems hard to believe, but we were so young when we met.

JAMES: That's exactly right. We were just children. But here's the thing. You had such a strong academic background, and then you had a strong Catholic background. You were even going to work for the Catholic university and you were very conservative. Did you know I was conservative when you met me?

JAY: Oh, absolutely.

JAMES: Did you respect me as a Baptist? I think you all sent us money.

JAY: Absolutely. We supported the ministry.

JAMES: Why in the world would you Catholics support this Baptist evangelist ministry?

JAY: Well, we liked the water wells. It is not that complicated.

JAMES: Well, we met. And Jay, the people that gathered around us, we couldn't believe the people that sat in the room together and were still talking to each other when they were taught never to get in the room together.

JAY: That's right. And that was one of the main themes of the book. It is the fractures in the body of Christ that have led to all the cultural things that Christians sit around and complain about. We think, actually, the body of Christ, we're not doing what Jesus said in John 17 so let's try to model that. We're not going to just pretend that there are no differences. We're not going to drop everything to the lowest common denominator but we are going to work seriously together. We've done that at the Stream and we did that in the book. I think it is one of the most important things, honestly, of this many years together is to bring Catholics and evangelicals together. Now, as we talk about in this book, there are a lot of people who aren't even believers that are in our country—

JAMES: Yes! And they love what we've written.

JAY: What's happened in these intervening years since we wrote *Indivisible* is that the culture has just gotten completely insane. So lots of people might have been fine with abortion, fine with same-sex marriage, they're not fine with gender surgery and men competing in women's sports or going into women's bathrooms, for instance. That wakes people up.

Back in 2011, 2012 we were worried, social conservatives, people who defended the family and life, were going to get kicked out. The country club Republicans were going to kick us out. So that's what we were worried about then. I'm not worried about that now. I'm worried about a lot more than that. The good news is that it wakes a lot of people up. The forces of darkness are usually most powerful when they're working behind the scenes. But when the abyss, the darkness itself is right there in front of you, that can have a different effect. It can backfire.

JAMES: Jay and I wrote this book *Fight the Good Fight* to show you how to fight the good fight and win it. It is not that tough. It's not tough for sanity to prevail if you hear it. And most of the media, I want to say 70-80 percent of them will never tell you the truth. But if you hear the truth and you look in on the truth, and when you read this, you're going to read the truth. You're going to find it hard to find a way to even argue with a chapter and think you're going to win the jury or even going to keep listeners.

I'm begging you, get this in the hands of every single American, every single person who cares one thing about freedom, one thing about security, one thing about peace, one thing about safety, one thing about law, one thing about family, one thing about marriage, one thing about a stable, safe, secure future—get them to read it.

I've read the chapter titles yesterday. You said you wanted me to maybe repeat the titles of several of them you wanted to comment on.

JAY: So it's the family chapter because the middle of this book is the family.

JAMES: All right. Listen to the chapter titles: "Man Shall Cling to His Wife." Chapter 7, "Male and Female, He Created Them." Chapter 9, "Multiply and Fill the Earth." Chapter 10, "Train Up a Child." Okay. Comment.

JAY: We need to think of the family as the cell of civilization. You can't have a functioning country, you can't have a functioning society if you don't have functioning families. Social scientists know this. We know this from reason. You don't need special revelation to tell us this. We know this from the sociological data. At the same time, we can turn to the first page of the book of the Bible in Genesis and what happens? God creates us. He creates us male and female. He creates us and then commands and blesses us, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth." That is a demand, sort of a divine command and blessing all rolled into one.

JAMES: And multiply, by the way, didn't just mean raise crops, but it didn't mean not raise crops. That was part of the multiplication. But it also meant having children. And two women and two men don't have children.

JAY: No, it doesn't work. That's the kind of fundamental reality that I think a lot of people didn't see in the debate about same-sex marriage that sort of effectively ended at least for a while with the Supreme Court decision in 2015.

But the forces that are attacking the family have continued. And as soon as we, at least legally at the federal level said, well, the complementary nature of male and female, those don't matter for marriage. In the next step, there is no complementary male and female. That's all sex assigned at birth. That is just a social construct that people have imposed on us. That's how crazy we are in our culture now. That something that was known to every person at every time and place in history is now up for grabs.

If you get poll questions that ask people what they think about this, between 75-90 percent of the public agrees with us. They think, okay, this stuff is crazy.

JAMES: He just told you, 90 percent of the public don't agree with this. But you're going to have something rock-solid you could put on the wall. A good communicator could stand up and defend it and he would not lose one juror in a trial. Not one!

I'm telling you—by the way, I know these principles. Jay knows how to show us more clearly historically. He knows how to show it through reason; that has been so confirmed in the highest level debates, and discussions where they're reasonable, honest discussions. You're going to have an airtight case against deception, and destruction, and division, and the loss of freedom. Can we go on with some of the other chapters?

JAY: Absolutely. Because of course, the family is in the middle and our foundational issues are at the beginning, God, country, reason, and revelation. And then we move into the economic questions and we don't shy away from those, including international trade and things like that. And frankly, on trade, I think the situation has changed. Maybe even ten years ago, we thought, that trading with China would hopefully help make the Chinese middle class richer. They'll rise up and sort of make these reforms permanent. Unfortunately, the hardliners in China won out over the moderates.

The reality is that we are intimately connected economically with China. So this is never going to be the same situation as we have in the Soviet Union where we just had an embargo. We were trading with the Soviet Union. It is much more complicated now but the reality is we need to face the fact that China is our primary adversary on this planet and that's just the kind of brutal reality that changes the situation in 2024.

JAMES: You know what Betty said to me? Because she keeps up with the news. This girl is the most active, she is the greatest political activist I know. We don't miss anything. We vote for everything. We vote for people I didn't even know were running for office. I didn't even know they had an office. She won't miss it because she cares. We're going to have 30 grandchildren probably by the end of the year. Do you understand? We have a big family. We had 60 in our immediate family. A kid that didn't

have a father. That's what can happen when a child of rape is allowed to be born, amazing things can happen. All life is precious. All life is—the only way you're going to stop abortion is to show the potential and the preciousness of every life—every life, no matter how young or how old. The potential is there. Well, this girl sees it. And so I don't remember what I was fixing to say.

BETTY: I don't know where you were going.

JAMES: But no, she makes sure that we're going to vote, that we're going to be active. She is the greatest activist I know.

Okay, Jay. Let's talk about these things right now. Betty keeps up with the economics and we were talking about China being such a danger. She said, "And they're buying up all our land. And they're buying our land close to many of our greatest military bases. How do we know who they're going to put on that land? Who they're going to arm or fund or enable?" We are building and digging our own grave!

JAY: It is completely insane. Because we talked yesterday about the sex trafficking and the drugs that are going across the border. But look, if you're Iran, or you're Hezbollah, you hate the great Satan, the United States, people think, do you think maybe they're sending some terrorists across the border? Why wouldn't they be? They're not stupid. Of course, they are. We've opened the borders.

JAMES: Of course, they are!

JAY: Of course, they are and who knows where they are? That's the kind of dark thing that everyone in security and intelligence recognizes. They may not say it publicly, but they realize, hey, we could be in a completely different situation. We used to talk about how we're fighting the war over there so you don't have it here. We're opening the war to come home, unfortunately.

JAMES: We've brought the enemy right here.

BETTY: And lawlessness has become the popular thing. There is no law anymore, no truth. They've turned truth into lies, trying to make you believe—they say, "Let everybody think the way they want to think." Except if you disagree with the way they think.

JAY: No, absolutely, yeah!

BETTY: And then you're the bad person. And they think that way about Christians.

JAY: Yeah. Absolutely. The thing now is to try to vilify Christians who simply think, we want to live our faith in the public square. We want to exercise, the free exercise guaranteed by the First Amendment. And critics act like you want to force everybody to be Christians. Like we're running around thinking, we're going to forcibly baptize people. I've never met anyone that wants to do that. It is completely crazy.

JAMES: "Am I My Brother's Keeper?" Our whole viewing audience loves to take care of their brother. But not because somebody made them or took it and gave it where they thought it ought to go. We see a need and we meet it with love. It is called unconditional redemptive love. That's what our audience does. You've seen them. Before you met me you were sending money to help us love people.

JAY: That's doing it the right way. Because voluntary charity can be an exercise of virtue. But the government is forcing you to do it and it turns it into something completely different.

JAMES: I say that any kind of charity without a compassion connection will likely be wasting somebody's money. You've got to have the compassion connection. "A Place to Call Our Own." That sounds like property.

JAY: It is exactly. The reality is economists overwhelmingly agree that the key ingredient that can make an entire country prosperous, and lift everybody out of absolute poverty, or not, is if you have title and property laws. We just take this stuff for granted. Every square inch in the United States is owned by someone, there is a record of it. The police will enforce the borders. But that's not true in a lot of the world. Certainly, in global South America, for instance, countries like Haiti, the vast majority of the land that people live on is not owned by them, and that prevents them from being able to create stable wealth.

JAMES: Same way with Cuba. It is just awful. We have "Global Trade and Globalism, the Threat of Communist China." Tell me about that chapter and its importance.

JAY: So we have to distinguish a couple of things here because a lot of people say, well, look what's happened to China. So they think, okay, let's not trade with anyone. That's the wrong lesson. The reality is that we know if more countries and individuals can trade with each other and focus on their specialties, on their comparative advantage, then they can trade for other things. It makes sense that the Norwegians don't grow their own bananas. They get them from Central America. They could but it doesn't make sense to do that. The economic value of trading, as long as it is a fair partner and a fair trade, is undeniable.

So what we don't want to do is to say okay, suddenly we go with China from global trading partner to global adversary. All of the sudden, we treat everybody outside of our borders as adversaries. That's as dumb as if Oklahoma and Texas and Louisiana decided to treat each other as adversaries and not trade with each other. That doesn't make any good economic sense.

JAMES: No. Okay, the last three chapters, "Be Fruitful," "Have Dominion," and "Till It and Keep It."

JAY: All of this has to do with that "Be fruitful and multiply." Because as you said, that

has to do with reproduction, having more after our kind. It also has to do with the creation of new wealth. What is the ultimate resource that God creates? We tend to think of gold and land and oil and things as though those are resources but those only become resources because we transform them into things. To make oil a resource we have to refine it and build machines that can use that energy.

So the ultimate resource is the human mind and human imagination that can create wealth that wasn't there before. That continues to be true, post-fall because we're still made in the image of the creative God. And that's one of the most important theological truths. It is probably the most important economic truth.

JAMES: When we create something, we have to oversee it, we have to manage it. We have to develop it, improve it, expand it, whatever. I just think it is the most amazing thing God's given us to be an overseer of his creation. And he gives us all this because he loves us. He wants to bless us. He gives us beauty to appreciate and admire, maybe even purchase some of it, but not be possessed by it. He doesn't want any of the beautiful things that he's given you to enjoy to become an idol and you begin to covet or desire or worship them and be distracted from everything that gives meaning to life.

That's what this book is about. Everything that gives meaning to life that we can oversee and protect. We can till it and grow it and be blessed by it and bless others by it. There is no greater blessing than blessing others. Do you know what thought just flashed into my mind? Maybe one, blessing him because when we bless others, we bless him. The joy of the Lord is our strength. And it is a joy to the Lord to watch us love others the way he wants to love through us. Father, give us that love, in Jesus' name.

CLAYTON: Human trafficking is modern-day slavery and it is broken up into two categories. One, labor trafficking, forced labor. And the other is sex trafficking. The best estimates are that there are 50 million people trapped in human trafficking, and five million of those are in sex trafficking. It is a \$150 billion industry.

I would not be in this work if I wasn't seeing lives transformed. That causes us to keep pressing forward. We have this built-in hope and redemption that we're seeing as we meet new girls that have been rescued. And God is still a rescuing, redeeming God and we continue to move forward trusting that he will restore lives.

Our team is great at building the case that will allow us to get warrants to shut down brothels and rescue girls. This is a thinking person's game. How do we outsmart someone who is operating in the dark corners of the world? How do we find out who is doing what, when, where, and how? And we're seeing success that we couldn't ask or imagine.

So much success that the second thing we do, we provide restoration care. Our restoration home is overflowing. This is a problem and guess what? It is a great problem to have.

This is something where God is answering our prayers to rescue victims of trafficking.

The third thing we do is we go upstream to the community; source communities trafficking where these girls are coming from and work in schools, and churches, and outreach programs to at-risk youth believing that heart transformation is the only long-term solution.

We're fighting a true evil. And we're seeing in the midst of that God transforming lives. And all of this is only possible because of partners like *LIFE Outreach International*. And with your help, we're going to keep going on this good fight.

JAMES: Do you realize that they are fighting for the freedom, not for them to have freedom like we're calling freedom, you know just to go out and do things like we want to do, they're living like in a cage. They're living in a trap. They are slaves but they're sex slaves and they're taken captive. And many of them we find already captured. But we're also, because of you, sending people out to find them where the sex traffickers are going to buy them. They'll buy them for a radio or a television or a little bit of money and tell them they're going to take—the family, they'll tell them, and we're going to give them an education and give them a job.

Yeah, they're going to give them an education all right. They're going to likely hook them on drugs and they're going to get them to be sex-addict trafficked people for the rest of their life. They're going to be used like a slave. Betty, you've seen it. It is the most awful thing. It is like animals in a cage being used for sex, for somebody's pleasure. And then we find them before they get them, we get them out after they get them, and then we get them and you'll even see how we begin the restoration process which that is like an education, it is liking a school.

And all of that takes love. Only love, Betty can provide that. The love of our viewers makes those miracles happen.

BETTY: It really does. This has always been a tough appeal for me because as a mother I can't even imagine my child being captured and taken away from those she cares about and those that love her. And being taken away, maybe possibly never to be seen again. And to be used and beaten and controlled like this, and their bodies to be destroyed because of the evilness of this world. I hope you see that in your heart. You look around at your little ones and you think, God, I'm so grateful.

Let's rescue these precious children. They never asked to be where they are. We used to think this is mostly in other countries. No, it's right here too. It is in our state, it's in our communities, our towns, it's not far away. So let's do what we can to now reach out and get these kids out of the entrapment that they're in.

JAMES: And yes, it works. Love never fails. And this is one of the greatest expressions of it I've ever seen.
