**TAMMY:** Hello everybody. I'm Tammy Trent and I'm so glad you're here. Welcome to *LIFE Today*. This is a special day for me but it is a hard one. I want to share some things with you that are heavy on my heart. I know it is hard to hear some of what I'm about to share with you. But could you imagine for a moment a little girl right now sitting in a dark, dark room that's probably filthy dirty, hot, and humid, and the conditions are absolutely horrible? She's broken and abused with no sign of real life, someplace far away from home and all alone and she's scared.

Now imagine she is praying that someone will come for her and give her a way out of that place. She is crying out for freedom and a better life, the one that she was promised. Wondering if someone would hear her. Will someone care enough? Asking if there is anybody out there that can help.

The horror and reality of human trafficking and the nightmare that it is for literally millions of children all around the world is very real. The thought of a scenario like that is almost unthinkable for us to imagine. The darkness swallowing the light, minute by minute one child at a time.

Human trafficking is a \$150 billion industry. An estimated 4.8 million women, girls, and boys are currently victims of sex trafficking right now, and it is the fastest-growing crime worldwide. The effects are severe and long-lasting, including long-lasting physical, emotional, and psychological trauma and disease and addiction.

Now would you believe me if I told you that it is possible to rescue that beautiful little girl and restore her back to life again? It is! Through our reach, rescue, and restore efforts, our team and mission partners are there on the ground right now and they are well trained and fully equipped, many surrounded by law enforcement, and they are not afraid to knock down the evil wicked doors of hell if they have to, to get to that child. And today, you have the opportunity to be a part of that with us.

Now imagine hope. Because we've seen the mighty work of God do what only he can do with a shattered, broken, wrecked life over and over again. And it is that hope that keeps us in the fight when they can't fight for themselves. It is that hope that takes us around the world to help rescue, reach, and restore one life at a time, especially for the many that feel hopeless, helpless, and trapped right now. Watch this.

**JOHN:** I'm here in Asia on one of the borders between two countries where children and women are being trafficked every day. We have mission partners at this border crossing that are trained to intervene. They are trained to recognize and know what to look for when it comes to potential children being victimized.

Can you imagine waking up thinking your child was safe in her bed only to find out that that child is gone?

>> When I was 11 years old, my sister and I were playing outside when a lady appeared and offered to take us out for some tea. She gave us some juice that made us fall asleep. We didn't know where we were when we woke up.

>> I was 12 when I met a woman who said she was a teacher and I could travel with her to be educated. But one day I woke up in a locked room in a brothel and she said I must work here now. If I refused or continued to cry, they would bury me.

**JOHN:** Listen, we can all agree it is our job as humans, as Christians, and as church to stop this industry of human trafficking. We have mission partners on these borders. We need more of them. There are more borders that need our help. So I'm asking you right now, go, help us make a difference in the lives of little girls. Help us prevent the pain of a mom and dad waking up to the horror that their daughter is gone.

**TAMMY:** Your daughter is gone. Your son is gone. Your granddaughter is missing. Your niece has been taken. Your grandson disappeared. I think if any one of us got a knock on our door today and heard those words spoken to us, our response would be: Tell me what to do. How do I get to them? Where do I go? Where do I start? We'd lay down everything to save them. We'd jump into the fight and do whatever it took to get to them.

And that is exactly what our mission is here at *LIFE Outreach International*. We can't just sit back and allow the enemy to steal children. He might have the power but he has no authority. This is why I'm incredibly grateful for our mission partners standing guard at those borders right now. They have pulled away 2500 girls from the arms of traffickers. But we need more of them. More of them to help stop potential trafficking. There are so many unprotected borders around the world right now and we can't afford to sit back and let that happen.

One of the most important parts of this mission to me is to reach these children before they are turned over to the enemy. The enemy of their souls, the enemy of their innocence, the enemy of their futures and their hopes and their dreams. We need to get to those children with educational outreaches to train them in how to watch for the signs, for the lies, and the tricks of a trafficker before they're taken.

But if they are, we will fight to get them back. Once that rescue takes place, there is a long road ahead back to healing again. But we are committed to walking that out with

them to do whatever it takes to restore.

I've been there. I've been in one of our Rescue LIFE centers recently in Central America. I've seen the girls who have life in their eyes again. I know they felt safe there. They were thriving just like they are in all of our *LIFE* centers around the world. They're learning new skills to earn a living. They are being taught the Word of God and who he says they are—and so much more.

I wanted them to know how sorry I felt for everything they've carried their entire short lives. It is so much more than I could ever imagine carrying myself. They inspired me. They were the real heroes because they chose to walk out every single day, walk out this healing process in hopes of finding wholeness, wellness, and healing again.

I'm praying for every mission partner and every child that enters one of our *LIFE* centers; that every little girl who comes into those places would come to learn that she was made for more, that God sees her and is for her and he promises to make all things new again.

Revelation 21:5 says: And he who is seated on the throne says, "Behold, I'm making all things new." And then he said this, "Write this down for these words are trustworthy and true." Jesus is faithful to restore.

So our Rescue LIFE strategy has three steps: To reach, rescue, and restore. This is what we do and this is what we need. We need people just like you to come alongside us in this enormous fight. And right now if God lays it upon your heart to give, your gift will be matched by amazing friends of our ministry with a \$320,000 match. **DAVID:** So when we look at these big numbers of statistics that are just demotivating, what we choose to do is we just choose to focus on the one. We work alongside law enforcement and so we rescue one today, we rescue one tomorrow, we rescue one next week because every single child matters to God. And so then they have to matter to us.

**TAMMY:** Every single child matters to God so they have to matter to us. It's true! From the beginning to the end of God's Word, he speaks about the importance and worth of children because they're so important to him. Jesus said in Matthew 19, verse 14: "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them. Do not stop them." He was talking to the disciples. "For the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." And these are precious, beautiful children made in the image of God their creator. And I believe also, as God's children, we have the responsibility to do everything we possibly can to rescue the

vulnerable, the weak, the abused, and the exploited before it's too late.

I can't imagine what that might look like and I don't want to imagine that. I just know that we have to get to them and get to them now. I know this is big. It is so big. And it is a growing problem. And many may even say how can I even make an impact? But you can and you are. Together we are making an impact. Lives are being changed at our *LIFE* centers. It is powerful. Our redeemer is powerful.

Recently, while on a trip with *LIFE Outreach* to Central America, I was taken to a private home with our mission partners where I sat at the feet of a girl in a small room. She had been so mentally beaten down for years and her heart was guarded and a little hard. She didn't know even who to trust anymore.

I told her, "You matter to God, and you matter to me, and you matter to us." I sat there and I listened to her story. We both spoke in different languages but understood broken English and broken Spanish enough to know that there was real pain and hurt and disappointment and anger and brokenness, and a longing for a better life.

Her abuser didn't even know she was there and she was so scared to be there talking to us. But I'll never forget after hearing her story I said to our mission partner, "Can I just say something to her?" And as I reached for her hand she immediately reached back for mine. And with tears running from my eyes, God gave me a word for her. And I began to speak peace and calling out every good thing inside of her, every gift and dream that God had given her and to not lose sight of that, to not lose hope. That she was brave and she was courageous. And that God had a destiny for her beyond this. And I believed it was possible for her to one day walk in those gifts and change the world around her.

I promised her that I would remember her and pray for her often. By this time, we were both crying and hugging. And I whispered in her ear, I said, "Jesus loves you and so do I." I actually wondered how she'd receive that having so much fake counterfeit love in her life and touch in her life.

But she looked at me and she kissed me on the cheek and she said, "Thank you! Thank you! I love you too." And it was at that moment I knew what she was feeling, the love of God. And I can see renewed love and hope in her eyes.

I had to fly back home but I knew our mission partners are there on the ground to continue the healing process with her and many just like her who need to be rescued from horrific situations and brought into one of our Rescue LIFE centers for support and love and restoration, and to learn about their Heavenly Father who will never leave them or forsake them and is for them.

So let's do this. Let's help give them a better life. Let's not be silent. Let's help them dream again. Let's take back what the enemy stole because they've already been bought and paid for by the blood of Jesus and they belong to him. They are nobody's slaves. Would you stand with me today? **TAMMY:** God's Word tells us that Jesus cares for and values little children. While statistics tell us that human traffickers could not care less for them. The only value to them is the money they can make for the traffickers who exploit them for sex and forced labor.

This was the case of two little girls, Abini and Belli, who were five and 7 years old when our mission partners in south Asia rescued them. Abini was living in the brothel with her

mother who was a sex worker. Her pimp was allowed to molest little Abini.

Belli was found in a remote village with a madame who was selling her off to an old man who was already abusing and using her for himself. His next step would have been to sell her to the local brothel in a major city.

The good news is, *LIFE Outreach*, along with our mission partners are rescuing trafficked children through education in their villages, SWAT team raids that are literally knocking down doors to brothels and restoring lives through one-on-one ministry outreach efforts.

Abini and Belli are now loved, safe, and cared for in our life center, getting an education, learning about the Lord, praying and singing as little children should be doing. Stories like these would not have been possible without your help. But there are still thousands of children around the world crying out for someone—someone to rescue them.

At *LIFE Outreach*, we have partnered with missionaries on the ground to reach, rescue, and restore children of all ages caught in the grip of human trafficking. We must continue this work and the time to act is now.

**TAMMY:** Thank you! Thank you! Thank you to our mission partners on the ground and Jesus for rescuing those little girls before they were about to be sold into a brothel, Abini and Belli. When I think of these two little girls being truly loved and cared for right now, and playing and running in a yard at one of our *LIFE* centers and smiling and singing and being taught about the love of God, and learning about their new identity in Christ, I just want to scoop them up myself and love on them myself.

It makes my heart so happy to be a part of giving back their life and introducing them to

the most genuine, deepest love they could ever know, Jesus who will never leave them nor forsake them, who loves them beyond measure without condition.

It also makes me want to shout and say thank you—thank you to you, our viewers, because we could not do any of this without your help. Through your giving, it made that rescue possible. And I know all of heaven was celebrating too. The Bible says in Psalms 82:4: Rescue the poor and helpless, deliver them from the grasp of the evil people.

We're doing that. It's working but there are so many more that need us right now. Why? Because there are so many evil traffickers, men and women in this world that are getting away with this crime of using force, manipulation and fraud to induce these children into going with them. It's hard to wrap my heart around the thought of another human being caring so little about the well-being of an innocent, helpless child telling them that they are less than, not important, worthless, without value, dispensable, someone's property. That they see no value in that life. They use them, abuse them, and eventually throw them away, and it is disgusting to me.

Children are being lied to every day by human traffickers and promised the world that better days are ahead for them and maybe even their families. So they trust the unknown and they go because they just don't know any better. So do you see why we need to reach them before this happens? Before they wake up to this hellish nightmare that will now become their life? A life of abuse over and over again, raped, and probably beaten or tortured, told that if they don't comply and do exactly what their traffickers say, they may even be killed. They are trapped. They are enslaved. They are in prison. And they have no way of escape unless someone can get to them.

I'm not asking you to get on a plane and search high and wide for every child that's been sold into sex trafficking but I'm reaching out right now to ask you if you would help us raise the funds so that we could train and send more workers to those unsecured borders to reach those children first so that we can locate children and make a plan to secure their rescue.

And finally, to keep our *LIFE* centers fully operational, so that we can continue to process of restoring every beautiful life that walks through those doors, one life at a time, back to life, back to wholeness, back to wellness, and healing in Jesus' name.
