Week 13: Rescue LIFE James and Betty Robison Robert Morris #1

In the studio

JAMES: Well, you need to know I'm excited about everything you enable us to do for his glory, especially for the people who are hurt and overlooked. But please hear me. We've got one of our best friends on this planet and one of the most popular people on this planet, one of the most appreciated and respected, and rightly so, and that's our pastor, Robert Morris.

Now listen to me. We can sit here—he's going to be on all week. We could sit here and we could rejoice in the glory of God in our lives, ministries, and families. But he impressed me to encourage you to hear this. He wants to invite all of us into the shadow and shelter of his presence, power, and oversight. And you have no idea what sheep, who live in that watch care of that shepherd will experience. When I was praying, he said James, I would sure like for them to know and experience what I long for them to experience and express. So that's the reason we're here all this week.

Now I'm going to be giving away a book, now listen to what I'm telling you. I'm going to be asking everybody to read this book this year. Betty, you know, you've read it. My assistant, who reads all the famous people's books, read through it in a week or just over. Here, 12 years of prayer and effort on two people's parts: mine and Jay Richards. This is what carried the founders and led them to the birth of the nation.

These are the principles that have to be in place that cannot be hidden or cast aside. Any relationship starting with marriage, family, business, athletics, nations, or entertainment, none can stand firm, reliable, and secure without all these principles in place. And if we

read this as a people, we will have a direction, a nation-correcting course, and totally

transformed, I believe, in less than 24 months. The greatest awakening in history. That's

the power of the principles. We're going to be giving it away.

But Robert is here to talk about a book that I heard him preach all these truths, *Dream to*

Destiny. This isn't just like your dream of some kind of fantasy destiny. This is his dream

for you and the destiny he has designed and desires for you. You're going to love this.

Robert is here and I want to tell you something, you're going to be blessed. Robert, you

and I have been together, you told me before we walked out here, 42 years. I want to find

out when we actually started. When did we first meet?

ROBERT: We first met when you came to Longview, Texas, which was shocking to me

because you were preaching in Los Angeles and Tulsa and Atlanta, and here you came to

our little city.

JAMES: Big stadiums and I came to Longview. Yeah.

ROBERT: I felt like it was because your friends were there. You knew Billy Foote; he

was the best man at your wedding. But you came and preached at our church on Sunday

morning before the crusade. I stayed back to try to meet you. I waited outside the pastor's

office.

JAMES: How old were you?

ROBERT: I was eight years old. And you came out, the biggest man I'd ever seen in my

life. Darkest hair.

JAMES: You can't tell watching on television, I'm 6'3". Okay? Go ahead.

ROBERT: I just knew—there was something there that God had put in my heart. I

remember telling you, "When I grow up, I want to be like you. And I want to preach to a lot of people." I wanted to help a lot of people; not just be in front of people but help them.

And you said, "Well, I'm going to pray for you." And you prayed for me, and then you got the Bible that you had preached from that morning and wrote a note to me. And what you wrote was, "I have nothing to prove. I have someone to please." And I've never forgotten that to this day. And you gave me that Bible when I was eight years old.

JAMES: May it always be true. Then you met me as a teenager and Betty. How old were you?

ROBERT: I was 18 years old. Debbie and I got to come to your home.

JAMES: Now then, you started working with me. How old were you?

ROBERT: I was 20 then.

JAMES: So that's how many years back?

ROBERT: Well, then they'll know my age if I say that. 42—42 years ago.

JAMES: Well, you and I have walked together because you went with me to all those big crusades. I couldn't do all the high schools. You know there were times when I'd be invited to the high schools and I'd just talk to kids about living with respect for authority, with respect for truth, and respect for one another, and their morality, and drugs and alcohol, all the things, sexuality out of control. But you started going to the schools for me because I couldn't keep up with all of them with all the—I'm speaking at every Kiwanis club, at all the different various lodges, the women's clubs. I'm going to leadership meetings. So you went to the schools and you would turn all the kids out. It was amazing.

So we've been ministering together for a long time. And then you started Gateway just over 20 years ago.

ROBERT: In 2000.

JAMES: A lot of our viewers were your first members. I know because I was sitting out there with them thanking God. So you've been on quite a journey.

Now, *Dream to Destiny*, God has one for everybody. Later this week, people are going to meet your son who is the pastor but going to be the one who will ultimately step into your place. That doesn't mean you're going to quit preaching because that is the last thing you want to do. But you're going to hear him. You're going to meet James.

But anyway, the deal is that God put this on your heart and publishers know this just had to be published. I want us to talk about it. What is it you want the reader and the viewer today to hear from God that you're trying to communicate through the book?

ROBERT: Well, I was going to speak to our young adults at the church and we kind of set an age group of 18-29 for our young adults. So I was thinking to myself: 18 to 29, what do they need to hear? And immediately, when I thought of those two ages I thought, well, Joseph was 17 when God gave him a dream. He didn't have to wait until he was 50 to be used by God. Our students, our teenagers, can be used by God. So he was 17 when he got the dream, and he was 30 when he became second-in-charge in the nation of Egypt. So he stepped into his destiny.

And I just thought *Dream to Destiny*. So what I'm trying to say to everyone is God has a dream for your life. God does. These dreams were from God. And God has a destiny. But then I started thinking about how God took him through some tests in his life to prepare him for the destiny; not to cause him to fail, but to prepare him.

I just felt like, you know how I am with alliteration. So he went through the pride test, where he bragged about it. He went through the pit test, and it wasn't even—in some ways, it was his fault, and in some ways, it wasn't his fault.

JAMES: He was thrown in by his family.

ROBERT: Thrown in by his family, that's right. He went through the palace test where he was tested with stewardship. He was tested in the purity test, which he passed that test. But then he got thrown into prison; so there's the prison test. So he goes through all these and then even after he steps into his destiny, we still go through tests. We're not finished learning at that time. You and I are still learning at our age. He went through a prosperity test where, for seven years, he prospered, but what was he going to do with it?

JAMES: That's huge! That's a huge test! The love of money is the root of all evil. Not money, not having money, but money having you or you just being in love with it is the source and root of all forms of evil. Understand? Money is not evil. If it has you it becomes evil. The love of it is evil because it opens the door to evil. Excuse me. I didn't mean to preach.

ROBERT: No, no, no! That was good. So that's exactly what happened. Because think about it, you said he saved two nations, and of course, there were other nations that came and brought grain. But if he hadn't saved it, if he hadn't been a good steward during those seven years, he couldn't have done anything during the seven years of famine.

Here's another big test he went through, the pardon test. In other words, when his brothers came back, would he pardon them? Would he forgive them fully? Because he even makes one of the greatest statements of the Bible. He said, "God sent me here to preserve your lives and the lives of others." And of course, we have this statement, "You meant it for evil, but God meant it for good."

I can tell you, even from personal experience, I felt like I had someone that did me wrong

and I just couldn't get over it. I'd wake up in the middle of the night and think about it. What you would do, what I would do is I would rehearse my speech to explain to this person why he was wrong. And it's like I was rehearsing.

And it was like I was keeping God up. It was like he wanted to get some sleep too. So all of a sudden it was like the Lord just said, "Would you shut up? Would you just stop? Just forgive him. Forgive him."

I said, "But Lord, he was wrong!"

And he said, "Of course, he was wrong, that's why you forgive him. You don't forgive people who are right."

It's like the biggest revelation. You know if you bake me a chocolate cake, I'm not going to say I forgive you for baking me a chocolate cake. It is when—so the other person is wrong. We have to know that, but that's why we forgive them. But we were wrong and God forgave us.

JAMES: In too many ways that almost—everyone.

BETTY: Talking about God's destiny for us, isn't that what we're talking about? How important, and I know in my own heart what it is but for people that are listening, how important is the journey towards that destiny? Because I feel like the journey God's had us on, it's been overall blessed. I've been privileged. But there's been a lot of heartache on the journey too. But so many important things God wants to teach us on this journey toward his destiny for our lives.

ROBERT: That's the whole point of the book, Betty. It is that all of us have a dream and it is probably implanted by God. We might mess it up a little bit, but God put it there. And we have a destiny he wants us to fulfill. But many of us live with the dream instead of in the destiny. And the reason is because we don't pass those tests.

Now here's the great thing about God. He's so good that when you fail a test, he'll just let you take it again. [Laughing] And he'll let you take it over and over and over, the pardon test, or whatever it is until you pass it.

JAMES: You know, this is something—and I kind of knew this, and might have implied it, but it hit me full force. Oftentimes, the subheading is more important than the title. The subheading not only will perhaps give you an indicator of what's in the book but it will actually give you a clear picture of what can come out of reading this book and letting this book be absorbed into your life and your mind. Listen to this: "A proven guide to navigating life's biggest tests and unlocking your God-given purpose."

If you will allow his purpose for you to be revealed to you, and then fulfilled through you, it is the highest level of fruitfulness in life and fullness in life. It's losing your life in his purpose to find it. Which his purpose is God's will through you, kingdom purpose fulfilled. Isn't that a powerful statement? And am I right? If people get the truths that you've shared openly, clearly, and simply, that anybody can get, if they become applied truth, they are going to experience a miracle of God.

ROBERT: And as you said, I shared them but I didn't make them up. The reason they're proven is they are from the Bible. They are from scripture and it is proven that Joseph fulfilled God's destiny in his life because of overcoming these tests.

JAMES: Robert, we will spend the rest of our lives trying to get people to reach the destiny, the design, and the desire that he has for them. And he alone knows what's best. I think you believe because we heard it when you preached it, this is expanded and clear. I think you believe it can change their lives.

ROBERT: I believe it with all my heart. Because every person has a purpose—every person! And you and Betty have been used to help and to feed and to reach millions of people, but there are a lot of people you guys will never meet. You'll never meet them.

Your kids will never play on the same soccer team as someone else's kids. You'll never be there. And when they go through a difficulty, maybe in their marriage or something, they're going to turn to someone who is watching the two of you, and they're going to say, "I need help. And I see a difference in your life." So every person watching has a purpose from God.

JAMES: And everybody can reveal his purpose to others. You are here to be a light in a dark world, and not allow that light to be hidden or covered by anything. It is on a lampstand. And the salt does not lose its effect of adding, not only flavor to life but also adding life to life, preserving life and everything that's precious. That's why we're here.

Robert, I want everybody that's watching to get the book. We will send it to everybody that helps us put God's arms around trafficked children, and girls that are being sexually abused. We'll be sending the book *Fight the Good Fight* for any gift. And we have other gifts for you.

But here's what we're asking you to do. And our viewers, you, you love the fact that we at *LIFE*, and Betty and I have gone all over the world, our team has been to 70 nations to be involved. Betty and I traveled, well, I traveled for 35-40 years, too much away from my family. Then we traveled to the ends of the earth. We went into the third world to help the overlooked, the desperate, the dying, the starving, the thirsty, and then we found the trafficked. And you, when we showed them to you, we didn't think you'd want to see them again. You made us show them to the world so you could put God's arms around them.

So we want you to help us continue to set the trafficked, sexually trafficked free. Some of our donors cared so deeply. Like I said, you made us, you insisted that we keep helping them all over the world. And we have. Some of our donors have given a matching gift of \$320,000. That's a lot of "want to help." So would you watch this? And then would you help us rescue one of these girls or boys? The average cost is \$128; it will rescue one. Since it will be doubled, you'll rescue two. \$1280, rescue ten, now 20. We're asking you

to do what you can.

I want you to watch this and then you ask God, "What do you want me to do?" He'll not only lead you, he'll enable you to do it. Watch.

>> My friend told me I could go work as a waitress. She took me to the owners of a bar. They gave me something to eat. After eating, I fell unconscious. When I awoke, I was being raped.

ANNOUNCER: From the bright lights to the brothels on any given night all around the world there are millions of young girls who thought they were going to work in a legitimate job only to find themselves in a situation just like Kim's, where their lives were turned upside down by sex traffickers. And that's where *LIFE Outreach*'s partners step in to rescue girls who have been forced into prostitution by human traffickers.

CLAYTON: Wherever we're able to arrest a trafficker, it's a huge win because not only does it mean that that place is shut down but that might mean that tens or maybe even hundreds of girls won't be trafficked because of them.

ANNOUNCER: SWAT raids are just one of the means our mission partners use to rescue girls. Others will reach out one-on-one and befriend girls who feel trapped in the world of sex trafficking. Once girls are taken into our mission partner's safe houses, their lives are forever changed.

JAMES: Betty, a moment ago, when we saw those girls in the beds, crawling out from under the beds, as so many watch our grandchildren grow up, not long ago they were that age, now we have all the great-grandkids coming up, doesn't it break your heart to see those precious girls being used as an instrument of evil and self-gratification?

BETTY: It really does. And the trusting soul of a precious little one, someone offers you help or food, something to drink, these little children, they're going to accept it. And then they take them under false pretenses, they feed them. And in their food, they have drugged them. And when they wake up, they're being raped and abused and just all kinds of horrible things happening to them.

I just can't even imagine. It breaks my heart. I know as you're watching, it must you too. Because you have children, maybe, you have grandchildren, you have those that you love so much. Let's please reach out and help these little ones. They don't have a chance if someone doesn't care about them. And God tells us we're to care about the little children and love them because he does. So help us, won't you?

JAMES: It's breaking my heart to think that men can be so twisted that they would want to use one of those little girls. And 747s go, more of them from the U.S. than any other nation, to the sex capitals of the world.

And here's the sad thing, many of them are stirred to that extreme sexual appetite by exposure to pornography. And now then, many of them are exposed to that pornography by the greatest free nation in the world and the greatest producer of pornography in the world, the United States. We're causing the men to have appetites out of control putting them where they will use those precious little girls.

And then where the people would sell them and tell them that they're going to give them

a job. And they've never had a job and they've never had money, and they've never had

opportunity. And then they not only use them—like that little girl woke up and she is

being raped. And then they get them on drugs. And they will hold them there. If they can

hold them for 20-30 years they will until they've just worn them out and destroyed them.

And we're setting them free. And you are building the greatest rescue houses on the

planet. And you're changing lives. And many of the little girls we started helping years

ago are now leaders in their communities. They're teachers, they're professors, and there

are one or two of them that are mayors. And I heard one of them was a governor—that

came through sex trafficking! That God's love, through you, rescued.

I am asking you right now to go get your bank card and use it like a check. You should

always use them that way. But use it like a check. Dial the number or go online. Do it
