Week 17: Spring Mission Feeding James and Betty Robison Tammy Trent Mission Feeding #1

In the studio

JAMES: You know what I was thinking? God, please, show me how to get people's attention. You know what I feel like he said back to me? I just wish I could get their attention. Isn't it amazing all that captures our attention other than him? I just thought, them—people that he's focused on, like you. He cares so much about all of us.

Tammy's here. Tammy Trent. My wife Betty is here. He's here, you're here. Listen to me now. I've said I wish I could get your attention. You've got to know this. This is going to be the greatest thing that ever happened to somebody that is beyond anything they ever imagined could happen. It is going to be as great a miracle as is possible for somebody to experience other than being raised from the dead. And I just heard in my heart you're basically, you're talking about raising people from the dead by the thousands. But they're dying slowly. But you can resurrect them with one act of love.

Tammy, are you glad that you work with us? Are you glad you met us a long time ago but then you ended up going to the mission field?

TAMMY: I am. Gosh, I'm already emotional. Just when you say people are dying slowly because we've seen it. We've seen it and I've seen it in this trip that we just took to Ethiopia. It was probably one of the hardest trips I've ever taken with you out of all the trips I've taken throughout my life with you. You can go to the headlines all around the

world right now and you can read about the devastation and how dire this is that malnutrition is rampant.

I have never seen something so horrific, truly, in front of my eyes. Watching child after child struggling and suffering. Many were dying before my eyes. That will impact your life forever and it has mine.

JAMES: Let me just say this, could you even bear to talk about it, bear to go and see it again if you didn't know there is a miracle that can turn that death into a glorious resurrection?

TAMMY: No, I couldn't. And I think that there were moments, James, when I was there where I'm hanging onto hope even for these children. There was one time I was there with a child that was just literally dying before my eyes and I couldn't take it anymore. I emotionally couldn't take it. I had to leave the room. I found myself a spot to sit and I just wept and I wept.

Because I felt like it is so urgent it has to happen now. Help has to come now. We can't wait, these people, these families can't wait. And to know even in that moment of my grief that there is hope, Tammy, there is hope. And you're working with an incredible ministry that knows how to come in here and help these people find life again. You're right, that gives me great hope to know that there is a solution to some of these really hard things I've seen.

JAMES: Betty, we started there 35 years ago. She's described it right.

BETTY: She has. James and I thought, okay, the first time we didn't know what to expect. It was all new to us. I thought, okay, I've seen it as bad as it will be. That's not so. Every time you and I went James, my heart like Tammy's would just be crushed. I thought, this can't get any worse. But if we don't help them, it does—worse and worse all the time.

But thank goodness because of the love of people like you and many, many others, we have been able to make a difference, James.

JAMES: Well, once we saw it, and we saw where Peter Pretorius, our mission overseer who is now in heaven looking down; and his son, Isak and his wife, and Ann, they're carrying on. But I'm telling you, we couldn't have gone back if we hadn't seen the power of the resurrection love of God.

And Betty, when we came back, we started selling everything. This building I'm in, this incredible studio, when it was finished, it was either the first or second largest in the whole Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex. It laid on the ground for three years. It laid in tilt-up concrete on the ground for three years because I said we're not going to spend one dime on any building or anything. We sold the most, let's say effective, many of the vehicles that we had to get around in, to travel in, we got rid of them to save lives. And it laid here until the missionaries came over and saw it laying here.

They said, "How long has that been laying there?"

We said, "Three years. From the time we met you."

And they said, "Well, we're fixing to pray it up." And they did, literally.

Once we saw what starvation is doing to children, what it is doing to families, what it is doing to communities and villages, and yes, nations, and the millions of people that were dying of starvation, and we had the answer so simply in our hands. I didn't know, Betty, when we sat here and started asking people to help, we did not have a clue if you would help. That's why we said we're going to do everything we can. Betty and I were doing everything we could do. All the sudden, our friends did.

But you know what? When you watched and you saw the need and you saw the fact that

we can work the miracle to give them life and a future, you jumped in. You carried us! And you're continuing to resurrect the dead.

I was told and you've confirmed it, and we're going to see you there in just a moment, you not only saw the most awful sights but you walked into a hospital that nearly tore your heart out. Now listen to me please. I want you to watch this because if you see what I know the Father in heaven wants us to see, and you care about what you see the way he cares about everything that matters to you, and those you love, that's how much he cares and he can do something about it if we just invite him in. The fact is he can do something about what you're about to see. We are the potential for the miracle that is a resurrection to life. That's what it is! And it is all an outstretched hand and a heart of love. That's what it is.

I want you to watch. Watch carefully, focus on it, pray that you will see what God sees, and what he wants you to see. And what these precious people desperately need you to see.

>> Malnutrition has immediate causes and it has underlying causes. One of the

underlying causes may be no access to food. And also malnutrition is intergenerational. So if the mother is malnourished, the possibility of the kid to be malnourished is more high.

ANNOUNCER: Right now, Ethiopia is in the midst of a tragic crisis and the children do not have enough food.

TAMMY: I've gone into a couple of hospitals in the past with *LIFE Outreach* and I've been around malnourished children but I've never come into a clinic like this today. I struggle to find those words, strong enough that you would believe me if I told you that children are dying right now. Right now, this very second, behind me they are dying.

JAMES: Do you understand that for 35 years plus, Betty and I, for over 20 years have been going and pouring our lives into it? And everywhere we went, they were at war. Pretty dangerous. The communists had taken over two of the countries with battleships, tanks, fighters, and armored vehicles. Terrifying!

But Betty, once we saw those children, and I was watching that little boy in the first part of that shot with his mother, I wanted to hold them both. You don't know how many times we've held little children that were breathing their last breath. And holding a mother who just watched her child breathe their last breath.

Listen to me. Betty and I are both 80 years old. She says, "Don't tell them I'm the same as you for heaven's sake." But listen, we've never stopped reaching out. Betty and I are among the strongest donors this ministry has ever had because we can't stop. Every time

we get more we give more.

Would you please, would you become the miracle? Betty, every viewer can reach out. They may not realize this but we would have reached out and picked up a few of the thousands but you literally help us pick up the thousands. You help us pick up all of them we see.

And then we tell the missionaries to keep looking because we've got people who are watching who see what he sees and loves like he loves because he is loving through them. And they're extending their hands to extend his hands and they're becoming the source of the miracle those people have been praying for.

Betty, we have seen these children who are dying, who are being buried. Their graves are being dug continuously. They had no markers. They had a little picture of a child or maybe some kind of symbol or maybe a little toy the child had. And thousands of graves. And then we see it turned into a place where these little children are singing. And then they learn how to talk English. We began to encourage them to go to school by telling them there will be food for them. You do that. Betty and I, you say "we," goodness, do you understand who the "we" is? You're the "we." And it is his body, the body of Christ. It is the family of God putting the arms of God around people.

Betty, I'm praying for the greatest outpouring of love we've ever witnessed in our life.

BETTY: What a wonderful opportunity. Such sadness, yes, that we've shown you. Mothers brokenhearted, even mothers malnourished. We need your help with the differences you have made and continue to make. Please join with us. And with joy and thanksgiving, let's give out to these precious little ones that are the innocent ones in this life. Give them an opportunity to grow up and hold their babies, their healthy babies. Please, keep helping! Or for the first time you think, oh, I want to do that! Thank you!

JAMES: Jesus would walk into a crisis situation, even death and pain and suffering, and

the miracle walked in the room. Do you realize you have the opportunity to be that miracle that walks into that situation? And guess who it is that's walking in in you? Jesus! Jesus shows up in his body, the body of Christ—that's us!

Tammy, what do you want them to hear, think about right now, and seek God and they think about those little ones and their family?

TAMMY: [Sighing] So many of these children are going to die today if we don't step in, if we don't show an outpouring of the blessings that God has actually put on our lives. We have been blessed. Every one of us now are in a better position than any one of these families that I've met in Ethiopia. We have the ability to change their lives today because tomorrow might not come for them.

So what I want you to know is that it is dire, it is critical, it is now, it's urgent! And if God has laid it on your heart to partner with us in this incredible opportunity that we've been given to pray it up, to outpour into their lives and to give them hope, and to give them a reason to live, that's what I would want you to know today straight from my heart. I've seen it. I've been there. And I've also seen what love can do, what our love together can do. It can save a life.

JAMES: Love—love never fails. But that love that never fails must have a channel through which it freely flows. God says he wants to shape us into vessels of honor. Channels through which he flows what? His love, his life, his truth. And yes, his miracles. You don't have to wish for a miracle. You can become the source of a miracle. And the only source of hope they have is the blessed hope of the Lord Jesus through us, his body.

Would you get that bank card and make the largest gift you can? Now you remember, \$30, \$50, \$100, we can feed three, five, or ten children. Why don't you try to increase that? I often ask those who could maybe give \$100, would you multiply it and rather than giving life to ten, could you give life to 100? Maybe a 1,000? I don't know what you can

ISAK: Tammy, this is one of the villages our teams have come to. Our emergency teams are doing some advanced work here to understand what is going on. Because what we've been told is that there are over 190,000 people in this area that are suffering, literally are in crisis—a food crisis.

The drought in this area means that they haven't actually had a harvest for eight years, seven to eight years. So we wanted to come and actually see and understand. This is the first time I've ever been to this village. You see how the community just comes out in mass. I'm thinking they've brought some of what they're eating to be able to show us, and to just share some of their story.

I can't help but looking at the little kids sitting around us and these kids capture exactly what we've just been talking about. These two little ones, they're so lethargic actually. You see how the little girl's hair is starting to change color. You can just see. This child is not in good condition. You look at the other kids around them and you look how their hair is on these little girls, and just the overall condition of these children.

TAMMY: I look at this little guy here, who we have just learned that he has lost his

grandfather. See for me, I understand deep pain. I understand loss. For me that happened later in life, my early 30s. You know I understood how to find hope in the middle of my pain. And this little guy, to me, should never have to feel the pain that he feels, the struggle that he feels.

They have no food, it's an emergency, and so we have to respond today. That is the hope that I want to extend to these precious people is the gift of life.

JAMES: I wanted to wipe the tear out of the corner of his eye. I just look at him—God loves him so much. They're so poor that a baby is the greatest prize a mother can have, a family.

Tammy, we can give them life, really beyond anything they ever experienced before they had the horrific experience that brought us to their crisis. We can actually resurrect them and take them to a life beyond anything they've ever seen. Because that's what God's love does when it flows freely through his children.

TAMMY: Yes! James, I feel the same exact way. It is heavy on my heart because there is so much heartache there as well. And there's a lot of hope and there's a lot of hopelessness. For me, to be in that footage, I remember holding that little guy and just weeping with him. We don't speak the same language and yet, there didn't even have to be words. They could feel the love of Jesus. They could feel that I was someone coming to offer them hope, a better life. Not me, but that I was coming in the name of Jesus. They knew it. That's the beauty of what we get to do every single day here at *LIFE Outreach*.

JAMES: Well, we only get to because of you the viewers. Betty, we didn't know what they would do when we started this.

BETTY: James, just really quickly. We just recently had another great-grandbaby. We're so blessed! And I look at the face of that great-grandbaby and I think, isn't she beautiful? She's so healthy. These mothers say, this is my child. But my child is not healthy. I want my baby to be healthy. And I think, God, we've been blessed. Let us be a blessing to those that are less fortunate. Please, give out of your heart. Your heart's big. I know you will.

JAMES: We've been given life by the source of life who gave his life to give us life, and we can share that life. Betty and I have been married 61 years, in love 65. I've been preaching 62. I've been all over the world and I'm not slowing down. We're doing more right now to reach people with the truth of God than we ever have in our life. We can actually do more to reach more people in one day than we could do in ten years. The church is the only power that can do that.

ISAK: Tammy, as we were coming into this village, we've heard that there are over 190,000 people in this area that are chronically food insecure. There's been six years of drought here.
