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Week 36: Christmas Shoes and Smiles James and Betty Robison John Zmirak

In the studio

JAMES: We welcome you to *Life Today*. We're here because you are important. God cares so much about you. His love expressed in Jesus is indescribable. Betty and I have prayed with all of our staff that we keep sharing that love and that truth. That's the reason I started The Stream to bring together very diverse individuals from various backgrounds, races, and nationalities; and to bring them together around principles that matter.

I'm telling you, everything we do is because God loves you and your family and wants the best for you. Betty and I have our hearts in harmony with his. That's what we want for you. That's why our guest today is one of the greatest, if not the most popular, writer for The Stream. He is one of the smartest people I've ever met. He's one of the most courageous, and he communicates indescribably with his pen and communicating. Eric Metaxas thinks the world of him.

He's written a book. I think the cover is just magnificently fabulous. It is so well done. It says *No Second Amendment, No First* Amendment. Now it's John Zmirak who wrote this. If you don't read his articles on The Stream—don't miss them—you don't want to miss them. John has written a great book.

The Second Amendment is more important than you can ever imagine. But here's the thing I'd like you to understand. The reason that the battle right now against this second amendment is so great is that basically, they've already done away with the first

amendment. That's how they think they can finally get at it and destroy it.

John, I'm glad to have you here on *Life Today*, and with The Stream. How long was this on your heart to write and the understanding, the importance of it?

JOHN: I was interested in it like three or four years ago. I started looking at the historical connection between gun control, done in the name of protecting us, and public safety. The connection between that and tyrannical governments persecuting unpopular minority groups, especially unpopular religious groups.

I saw what had happened to the Christians in Iraq in the wake of the Iraq war. I'd seen, of course, what happened in Rwanda in the '90s. And then looking back historically, I started to read the history. There is a very powerful book by genocide scholar R. J. Rummel, it is called *Death by Government*. He documented that between 1914 and 1990, 170 million civilians, at least, 170 million civilians were intentionally murdered by their own governments; that doesn't include casualties of war or death by negligence—intentional murder.

What were the common factors? What was the single common thread between all those victims from Cambodia to Rwanda to Germany to Poland to Spain?

JAMES: As well as the Soviet Union.

JOHN: And China, one thing connected them. They had all been disarmed by their governments first. The Weimar Republic, the most democratic constitution in history, had very strict gun control. Of course, the Nazis and the communists just disobeyed the law but all the law-abiding people registered their guns. So when the Nazis took over, they were able to say which Jews have guns? Which members of labor unions have guns? They collected all the guns in the build-up to Kristallnacht when they attacked all the synagogues and burned them and started beating Jews up on the street. The same thing happened in the Soviet Union. Lenin, the first thing he said was, "Seize the food." The

second thing he said was, "Seize the guns." It happened in Mao Tse's China. It happened in Cuba under Castro. It happened under Maduro in Venezuela in the late 1990s. And now, it's happening in America.

If you look at other Western countries, where the civilians have been disarmed by the government, you find that the government is in no way afraid of the people. We want the government on some level to be afraid that if they push the people beyond a certain point, if they violate their most fundamental rights, something might happen to that government. That's what James Madison said. The reason the Second Amendment passed unanimously was that Congress, and all the founding fathers, supported gun rights. The reason was expressed by James Madison in the Federalist Papers. He said if all the checks and balances, and the separation of powers and the federalism and all the mechanisms that I put into place in this constitution to frustrate a tyrannical government, if they were to all fail, and of course, we see they are failing now in front of us, if they were to all fail, there still would be a militia of half a million armed citizens who would frustrate any tyrannical government.

Well, if you look at countries like Germany, homeschooling is illegal. They would never try that here. Why? The people are disarmed in Germany, they are not disarmed here. In Canada, pastors are going to prison for citing Leviticus's teaching on sexual morality. They are going to prison for hate crimes. They don't have—people have been disarmed in Canada. The existence of an armed citizenry is the last backstop. It is the in-case-of-emergency break glass if the government gets out of control.

The U.S. army couldn't hold Afghanistan. Do you think the army of a tyrannical government could hold Texas and Oklahoma and Mississippi and all the red states? We came very close to a totalitarian state right here right in America under COVID. That is what goaded me to finish this book and make it as good as possible. To wake people up to the fact that without the second amendment, without a citizenry that is as well armed as it can be, that has comparable weapons to the U.S. military, because remember, when the second amendment was written, they said citizens could have the same guns as the

continental army. In fact, cannons were covered under the Second Amendment. There are multiple court decisions that you can have cannons under the Second Amendment. The intent was clear to have an armed citizenry so they could be safe from the government.

If you take away the Second Amendment, it just multiplies the whole rest of the Constitution by zero. It is like, James, I'm going to make you a millionaire. I will pay you a million dollars: \$1 a year for a million years. That's how much the Constitution means without the second amendment.

BETTY: Do you think people are beginning to get it?

JOHN: I think so. I think so. The Supreme Court has been ruling well. They just recently ruled that New York state violated the First Amendment. New York state tried to shut down the N.R.A. by going to all its banks and insurance companies and all its vendors saying, "New York City won't do business with you unless you cut off the N.R.A." It is this thing called debanking. And they say explicitly, "It is because we don't like your views."

The left has cut itself off from the vision of the human person on which America was founded. America was founded on a vision of the human person as an image and likeness of God who has moral responsibility and fundamental rights. The left has rejected that and they see us instead as ants in a colony who should simply obey the instructions sent down to them from the top down.

BETTY: They're saying they want you to have one view and it is their view. And if you don't, it is wrong. And now it is becoming against the law, almost.

JOHN: Right! They don't want to persuade you. They've given up on persuasion. What they're relying on is force and fear. They will throw anything at the wall and see if it sticks. This is the kind of thing they did in communist Poland to Lech Walesa and solidarity. We have to realize what time it is and where we are. We are in communist

Poland right now. These people—I describe them as the Gadarene swine thundering down the cliff to drown in the sea.

JAMES: Well, they want to drown a lot of people with them and destroy them. Betty and I agree 100 percent. You're going to see how she jumps in. Let me just say this. There is something very concerning to me right now. We have led a million people who are likely to be terrorists themselves into the country who can be bought for \$100 to kill anybody, who could start trouble anywhere. I want to protect my family. I want to protect my neighbor. Betty and I both—and by the way, I'm a lifetime member of the N.R.A. I don't think she is—but both of us have the right to carry. Both of us want to protect our family and our neighbors, and we believe it is right. We don't bat an eye about it. Now you didn't even own a gun.

JOHN: No, I'd never handled a loaded gun until like 2021. I was already working on this book and I said, well, I ought to get a gun so I'm not such a hypocrite writing about the Second Amendment. [Laughing] I grew up in New York City where only the cops and the criminals have guns. And you count on the cops to maybe show up and draw a chalk line around you after you're dead. That is the model that the liberals and the Democrats want for America.

One of the most poignant chapters in *No Second Amendment, No First* is where I compare the fate of the Christians in Iraq to the Christians in Syria. In Iraq, when we fought our stupid, pointless war in Iraq and conquered the country, we imposed American-style gun control. The Christians all obeyed the law and turned in their guns. Guess who didn't! Everybody else, especially ISIS. So it would be funny except that 750,000 Christians, who had been there since the second century, they've been there since the apostles, were killed or driven out by ISIS and other Sunni militias. You go next door to Syria, the same kind of Christians, both speak Syriac, both have been there since the third and second century, they armed themselves. They disobeyed the gun control laws. They formed militias with the curds and conquered ISIS. Two side-by-side countries, it is like God gave us a laboratory experiment with one as the control and one as the

experimental group.

When you disarm unpopular religious groups, they get murdered. It happened to the Jews. It happened to the Christians in the Middle East. Right now the Armenians are being persecuted in Azerbaijan. The people are disarmed and helpless, and they're soon going to be cowering in their homes. That can't happen here.

JAMES: Let me try to bring this to a conclusion. The book is absolutely fabulous. John is. You pray for him. You've got a gun. You've got good with it. He wants to protect himself and his neighbors, and with what's come into our country and coming in, we all may need to be the protector of the people we love. So don't hesitate to be that.

Get this book and share it. Get it out and let's protect the Second Amendment because we're already losing the power of the first. If we lose this one, it is like he said, the enemy takes over the world and destroys freedom. Jesus died for our freedom. He wants us to live for freedom.

I'm asking you please, go to *The Stream*, let us help you understand why things matter, why principles are absolutely imperative for a marriage, for a business, for entertainment, or sports. There is nothing that works well without the basic principles that we're teaching continually on The Stream like our founders did with very diverse leaders who love freedom and love you. This is really, really important.

John, you know we do everything we can to put God's arms around a hurting world. Our viewers are the most amazing people. That's why I'm going to be surprised if they don't help us preserve the First Amendment and the Second Amendment and understand the importance, of course, of both. ANNOUNCER: In the heart of Africa lies an oasis of healing. That special place is the CURE Children's Hospital of Uganda. Doctors here are well-known for their specialization in neurosurgery. The children who arrive here are usually born with neuro disabilities like hydrocephalus, which is an excessive accumulation of water on the brain. Left untreated, about 80 percent die before reaching adulthood.

LIFE Outreach is partnering with Cure to help save the lives of these precious children. Children like Oloka Favor who is following up with his doctors for the third time.

ASHTON: I'm standing here in the CURE operating room with Oloka right behind me. He is four months old. I was speaking with his mom, Maurion, just a few minutes ago. She is 20 years old. Her baby, Oloka is sitting right here and he is about to go into surgery.

months old. I took him to a hospital but they could not help. Then a friend referred me to CURE.

ANNOUNCER: The doctors that gathered to operate on Oloka Favor agreed upon a procedure to insert a single shunt to divert the access water on his brain. The operation was a success.

DR. TOMSON: Apart from this being a Christian organization, I'm a born-again Christian, when you deal with complex operations, you realize that it is God that leads you through it. We cannot do this work without him, definitely. That's why we need that prayer every operation.
