# 10/14/24 Week 42: Mission: Rescue Life James and Betty Robison Lisa Bevere #1

## In the studio

**BETTY:** Welcome to *LIFE Today*! Thank you so much for joining us. I'm Betty and this is James. We're so delighted, James! We have one of our dearest best friends here, Lisa Bevere. So you're going to get blessed.

JAMES: I'm telling you, over 30 years we became family. She actually kind of made me like a dad. She's asked for my help to keep John in line. It's taken both of us—it's taken all of us. Hey John! We've had some serious talks, haven't we? I've even refereed a few of those serious talks. I love you guys so much!

Here's a book Lisa, she's always stirred when she writes something. I got the impression she was stirred up at the highest level, maybe ever, in *The Fight for Female*, "Reclaiming our divine identity." That's really connected to God, divine, not people's opinions. So I'm anxious to hear what she has to say.

Lisa, it is really good to see you. You're still beautiful. How is John doing?

LISA: He's doing great! He is enjoying being a grandfather. We have nine grandkids now.

## JAMES: Isn't that great!

**LISA:** Yes. He loves it. Takes them golfing. He's loving it so much. And pickleball. He's all about pickleball right now.

**JAMES:** He can golf. When I first met you, John, I kind of felt sorry for you because I could beat you pretty easily. But it ain't that way anymore, buddy. It's not just because I've had staph. You've gone up high.

Okay. *The Fight for Female*. I have an idea you got stirred. Something stirred you to write this, am I right? What stirred you?

**LISA:** Well, it's getting hard for me to meet somebody older than me. I was ministering at a church and afterward, the matriarch of that body came up to me and she said, "Did you ever know a Derek Prince?" I said I didn't. She said, "We hosted him one time. When my husband and I drove him back to the hotel room, we looked back and he was weeping. And we said, 'Brother Prince, why are you crying?' He said, 'I see an attack coming against the women. And if the enemy can get the women, he will get the children.'" It just riveted me.

Then I had this dream back in 2016. I'd love to say I have dreams because I'm spiritual. I think I have dreams because God is like she is not paying attention. We're just going to have to interrupt her sleep. I had this dream, James and Betty, where I entered a room filled with women. The women were all carrying around different rainbow-colored baby dragons and they were dressed in children's clothing. And it was in 2016.

I went from woman to woman. I'm like, "Do you understand you're carrying a dragon?"

And they were like, "Oh, these are different dragons. These are the wise, kind dragons."

I was like, "No, no, no! There is no agreement between daughters and dragons."

They were like, "Don't be afraid! Just pet it."

I'm like, "No! I'm not petting your dragon."

At the end of the dream, a woman thrust her dragon towards me and I reached out, grabbed it by the neck, and broke its neck.

I woke up and my arms were flying and I thought, what just happened? I wrote the whole thing out. And then I started to see what was happening with our children. How our children were being sexualized. How our women are being sexualized. We've got women sexualized and silenced. I thought, what is going on? Then I realized that we are in a Revelation chapter 12, verse 17 moment. "And then the dragon was enraged with the woman and went to make war against her children."

And I thought wow! You can fight me all day long. You come after my kids, there is going to be a different story. I feel like right now the enemy has somehow made the women agree that the dragon is an ally when he is not. He is after our children. Our children are being told that they were born in the wrong bodies. Our children are being told that their house is divided, that their gender ideology is this, and their physical body is that, and that they were made a mistake. Well, if a generation believes their very formation is a mistake, how are they going to trust God with their transformation?

So I wanted to go into this as a mother's voice. I have to be honest with you. When I started writing this book, I was angry by what I saw. But as I dove into what was going on, by the end of the book I was heartbroken. This is an attack against our children. This is an attack against women's voices. This is an attack against the image of male and female in our culture right now, and I just couldn't be silent.

JAMES: Don't you think that the children being exposed to, without oversight and control, to everything in social media, destroying their ability to even think straight? Don't you think they're being continually seduced and attracted and distracted from what is right and attracted to that which is very dangerous and destructive and deceptive? Don't

you think that's happening?

If mom and dad, if the family don't bring this under control, them being out of control we'll find ourselves under the control of the deceiving spirit, and the deceiver takes everything down. He tears everything apart. He is the father not only of lies, he is the father of division, he is the father of dissension, and he is the father of destruction. That's who he is. And you can see what he's doing. When I hear you saying what you're saying, you're saying we need to be who God designed and desires us to be as men and women, as husband and wife, as a family that is the family of the ultimate Father. The Father who wants best, always knows best and can guide us and direct us to best and enable us to help others find that so we are becoming a great witness for the Father.

And that's what—I don't know, I hear you when you're saying, *The Fight for Female*, I'm hearing you say fight for who the father designed and desires us to be.

**LISA:** Yes. My grandmother gave me this serpentine gold necklace when I was a teenager and I thought it was the coolest thing ever. I wore it all the time. My mother would tell my grandmother, "You shouldn't give it to her. She doesn't understand the value of a gold necklace. She won't take care of it."

And sure enough, I left for college, shoved it in a bathroom drawer, and bent it. Came back for summer break and I tried to find the necklace but I couldn't find it. And my mom was like, "Hey, I have it."

I said, "Oh, good! Can I have it?"

She said, "No. You didn't understand the value of this and now it is bent out of shape."

I feel like right now we have not understood the value of our femininity and now this connection between male and female is bent out of shape.

This is crazy, you're probably not even going to believe this happened but I went to meet somebody for coffee and I was wearing a T-shirt that said: "The future is male and female." I had some men come up to me and were like, "Thank you! Thank you for including us in the future." I'm like, "You're welcome." Then I had some women say, "I need that T-shirt."

So I thought, okay, everybody is happy about this T-shirt. So I took a selfie of myself in the car wearing the T-shirt and I just wrote underneath it, "The future is male and female because without male and female, there is no future." That's just biology. That's just your parents. That's not even deep. 922 comments later, people were enraged. People were like, "This is coding like all lives matter." "This sounds like you are co-signing with patriarchy!" "Women, it's our turn now. It's not the men's turn now. It is our turn." People just went after it. They were yelling I was a bigot, I was a demon of hate. I mean it just—and then people started fighting with each other. I'm like what in the world is going on?

So I've learned any time something is that charged, there is something more behind it. So I just went home and I typed in to my computer, "What is the origin of the quote, 'The future is female?" And I found out it was from a 1975 lesbian separatist group called Labyris.

You think, what's Labyris? It is the two-headed axe carried by the Amazon and the Greek and Roman goddesses. They believed that lesbians should live completely separate from males, and even heterosexuals for a time period. It was part of a presentation called: "What a well-dressed dyke would wear." They said, to quote, "The Future is Female" was a call to war, an invocation, and a spell to cast for the good of all." This is a Washington Post article talking about how Hillary had brought it back into her campaign and 25 percent of the proceeds of "The Future is Female" will go to Planned Parenthood.

I was like what? We have child sacrifice. We have spells being cast. We have a separation when God said, God said it's not good for man to be alone, that male and female together were a power union. Now we see this power struggle. I just had this

revelation. I looked at this and my grandson rides his bike over to my house. Asher comes in and I said, "Asher, what are your thoughts on the quote 'The Future is Female?'"

He paused. He said, "That I'm unnecessary."

And I thought, do I want my grandson or my husband or my brother or our coworker like do I want the males in our world to think they are unnecessary? Goodness! This is a nightmare!

Right now, I don't know if you know this, suicides are at the highest rate they've ever been in young men 24 to 35 because they do feel unnecessary. So I want women to remember that they are the multipliers, they are not the dividers. They are the ones that take what is not good and make it so very, very good. Right now we have a lot of men, we have a lot of men presenting as women but I'm not completely surprised by that because women have been acting like men for decades now. So why are we surprised by that?

JAMES: They acted like that was something to be achieved. A goal to be—

**BETTY:** That's the destruction of the enemy. First of all, he wants to break up the home, and the family. He's been able to do that with the young people, with the kids through all the social media. We don't take time with our kids at the table. I know when I was growing up, I didn't live in a perfect family but we had meals together. We sat down at the table together and we communicated with one another. I think that's so, so important. The enemy hates that communication.

I feel like I'm glad I'm a woman. I'm not ashamed of it. But I feel like it is sad to see men, boys that think they're a woman. They're who God created them to be. I think that's just the ploy of the enemy. Just to tear apart everything good God has created. We should be glad—I never felt I was lesser than James because he's a male. I'm glad. He's my protector. But he has never treated me like I was his slave or any less than him as a man. We have respect for one another, for who we are, who God created us to be, and I think we need to get back to that.

LISA: A hundred percent!

**JAMES:** Lisa, we've been married 61 years and you've been part of our journey for 30 years. Would you say the four of us got pretty close?

LISA: Yes, absolutely.

**JAMES:** What did you see in us and have you watched in us for 30 years that has in some way perhaps inspired you?

LISA: I'm going to probably surprise people with this but I remember John and you sitting in the front and Betty and I sitting in the back. John was trying to convince you of something. You looked at John and said, "Hey, if my wife had enough moxie to stand up in front of these other men and say, 'No, I disagree,' I think I'd listen to her."

People don't understand that Betty is so much of your strength and that you honor her wisdom. Betty is not just an accessory, she is a necessity in your life. I think too many people don't understand that dynamic of celebration. I know that when Betty says something, it needs to be weighed heavily. I know that you modeled that for John and me, that were you working together, that you are a partnership, and that you are one. And one doesn't mean same—one means that you celebrate your differences.

And going back to what you say about the—it's so crazy. When John and I were 25 and 24, we had a missionary from overseas pull us out of a crowd basically and say, "Hey! I want to take you two to breakfast. I see the hand of God on your life."

I was like, really? Because I don't even see it on our lives.

He said, "I want to tell you some of the things I see coming in the future." And he told us a number of things. He said, "I'm seeing a spirit of rebellion attacking the households in America. It is going to break the parents and the children's relationship." He said a couple of other things. And then he closed out with saying, "I see a day coming where people's lives will be controlled by a box they hold in their hands."

We thought he was senile. I mean it was 1984. We're like a box? But look at the phones and people are being controlled and swayed by what they can hold in their hands. Their very posture is looking down instead of lifting their heads.

We need to realize that what we're wrestling with isn't even a gender ideology, it is an unmaking of the image of God. It is an attack on the image of male and female.

**JAMES:** If you could condense and summarize the message you pray captures everyone who reads *The Fight for Female*, what message do you want to capture their heart and the direction you pray they go?

**LISA:** I believe that this is a message of rescue and redemption. I believe that people haven't known what to say so they've been silent. I wanted to give them conversational and practical and prophetic insights in this book so that there can be redemption and restoration.

JAMES: And do you believe we can see that?

**LISA:** I do. I do. But I believe we need to fight it in the spirit. And then we need to outwork it in a practical way.

**JAMES:** I think you laid it out very beautifully and practically. Let me just say a prayer right now.

Father, I want to pray for this couple that we've loved so much. For 30 years we have felt

like family with Lisa and John. We've enjoyed relaxing and resting times together. We've enjoyed real tense discussions. We've enjoyed taking on the challenges. We've found that we've taken on even as a foursome family; not two couples trying to get everything straight but two couples loving you and loving one another and loving our children and now our grandchildren.

Father, what Lisa has shared, she's been given an incredible gift to communicate, just like John has. They are an amazing couple. Both have a tremendous gift to write. And Lord, so I know there is fire and inspiration in this book. I pray every woman will get it. Lord, I pray that men will get it to just try to understand what *The Fight for Female* is like, and the fight against female, and the fight against marriage and the family; and Lord, that we will win.

I just hold this book in my hand right now and I ask you to bless the message. I want you to bless John and Lisa in everything they do; in Jesus' name.

What would you say to our viewers that you would encourage them to make a priority focus in their prayer right now?

LISA: I think this is the time to drop the stones and hit our knees. I believe this is a time to stop choosing sides and to declare, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done." I feel like this is a time for the elect to return to God and that God would heal our land. And that we need to use our privilege of voting. We cannot assume it is for everybody else or think because we don't like something that is not perfect, we need to have a guideline of the scriptures on how we vote, and not do it on personality. I feel like this is a time that we pray for our leaders. We pray for our leaders every single day as an organization. We need to pray—the Bible admonishes us to pray. I think too many people are not praying right now.

**JAMES:** You're calling us back to the principles that made women so effective and revealed how incredibly important they are. It is a challenge. So I hope, I pray you'll get

the book.

Lisa, we're going to ask our viewers to help with what you helped with, you and John. You supported our mission outreaches. You've been in many of the areas. You've seen the sexual trafficking, as well as the starving children and the thirsty children. You've been all over the world with *LIFE Outreach*, and you've supported the outreach of LIFE. You and John have been one of our best supporters.

I want you to just listen to the journey of a girl that God's love through people like you gave a chance—a chance at real life. We sure love you for putting God's loving arms around the overlooked. Watch closely and prayerfully, and then reach out and set a girl free with God's love. You can do it. Watch closely.

>> I remember walking down the street and seeing this little girl and trying to talk to her, and she couldn't focus. She was working every night at the age of three and being drugged. Imagine a three-year-old child dressed in a very skimpy outfit like a bathing suit with full-on makeup.

And this little girl was forced to dance for about maybe seven hours a night. Because she couldn't obviously perform for that long, they would give her drugs. For two years, we tried to get this girl off the street. And then the police, a really good commander came on board. So they went and picked her up. So I remember her coming in here. I remember her sitting here at 4:00 a.m. on the floor of this room. Within a half an hour, she was back to being a child playing with toys, eating pizza, and hanging out with the social worker.

The first thing they do is build trust. They make sure the child is fed. They have clothes. They feel comfortable and they're trained forensically. What that means is that first of all the information can legally be used in court. Our specialists know child development. They know appropriate questions. They know how to ask questions that don't retraumatize a child that's been through probably the most horrific experience of his or her life.

Now she is one of the first in her class. She has an amazing family. She has little kittens. She has about four kittens right now. We went to see her. She is doing gymnastics. So this is the value of this. It is much more than we have toys, we have kids. This is where kids come. This is where their life changes. Take somebody from the street, on drugs, and give them their life back.

And I always say, could you rescue ten with a \$1280 gift? I know that may be big. It is going to be huge to those you rescue. And now you won't be rescuing ten, you'll be rescuing 20.
