Studio Discussion:

RANDY: Welcome to a very special *Life Today*. You are going to see something that I hope you will choose to be involved in. Because right now the situation is very serious in many parts of the world where people lack something very basic. That basic necessity -- clean drinking water.

We have a program called Water for LIFE where we have been reaching into multiple nations around the world for many, many years. It is very successful because it works and it saves lives. But right now, the situation is as urgent as ever. There are over 800 million people worldwide who do not have clean drinking water.

We have a goal this year of reaching 20 nations with 350 water wells to give them life. But we can't do it without your help. Tammy, I know you've seen some very difficult situations but yet, I know you've seen the success of this.

TAMMY: I have seen it both. The hardest part for me as I've traveled the world with *LIFE Outreach* for I don't know, 16 years now, a long time. So I've seen a lot. The hardest thing for me to see is children suffering. For any one of us, we would do anything to help these kids. I've sat with these kids. I've gone to waterholes with these kids. I've played with these kids. I've jumped in the water. We've celebrated together. Those are the good days.

But there are a lot of hard days. I would do anything to help these kids not feel afraid, not feel scared, and to think that they might die. I want to show you something that touched my heart so deeply. I think today, if you lean in a little bit, you might see why. Watch this.

Transition Roll-in:

TAMMY: Millions of children around the world do not have access to safe, clean drinking water. As a result, they have no choice but to collect contaminated water from sources like this. Many times water from these sources is full of disease and bacteria that can cause serious sickness or even death, especially in younger children.

- >> The water hurts me right here. Then it hurts my head. It makes me want to vomit.
- >> When I drink the bad water, I feel it in my stomach.

When my sister died, I got very sad. Because I'm scared that my little brother will die also.

>> The only water we have is from the little pond. I'm afraid I might die like my brother and sister.

TAMMY: These children represent millions of others around the world whose lives are in danger every day that they drink contaminated water. We can give them a better choice. Working together, we can drill new water wells that provide safe, clean drinking water to thousands of people who live nearby. Please help us today.

Studio appeal:

TAMMY: The cry of my heart will always be, please help us today. Please help these children today. The greatest part of that piece is the ending where you see that rig. Everything is set up. The water, new life -- new water springing forth. I know that their lives are about to change forever.

I would love to go into every single village that God sends me and just behind me, I've got the rig. Behind me, I'm ready to drill, to bring water in Jesus' name. The reality is it is just not possible unless we have help, unless we have your help to come alongside us and make it possible for these families.

Randy, we've been doing this a very long time. We know how to do it. I feel like many times our mission partners are there waiting to get the call from us to say, we've got it! We've got it! Go! Go! Go do it! Go drill the well. Go drill that.

RANDY: The reality is the more that you help, the more that we're able to do. Our goal for this year, this is a goal, 350 wells in 20 nations. I know we can do that with your support. Now, I'll give you a quick breakdown before I show you some other pictures I want you to see. The average well is \$4800. We go around the world, in some places you have to drill deeper, some places it is harder to make that casing ensure that it lasts a lifetime. In some places, it is just harder to get into. The terrain can be very difficult. Many of these places are very remote.

But the average cost is \$4800. Some of you could say, we would love to drill a well. Maybe my company can do it. Maybe as a couple. Whatever -- our church group, we'd love to do it. Please do. I'm telling you, you will change lives in ways that you really can't fully imagine.

We've seen it. We know it works. You can be the reason that the children are dancing as the water comes shooting out of the ground. So I would encourage you to do that. \$144 will give clean drinking water to 30 people for a lifetime. A gift of \$48, something I think almost everybody can do, give clean drinking water, not to one person, or two people, five -- ten people!

These children, when they get that first cup of clean drinking water, wow! The smiles, the dancing, the celebration! Tammy, this is what it is all about.

TAMMY: It is what I go for. The heartache is hard. The suffering is hard and I think we carry that, Randy. We go in and we carry that as a team and we're trying everything to make life better for them. But when the celebration comes, we're in it with them.

RANDY: The celebration is so worth it. Do you know why the celebration is worth it? Because the pain is real and I think you need to see both sides of it. I want you to meet someone in a place that didn't have clean drinking water and hear her story. Watch this.

Transition Roll-in:

RANDY: In so many places around the world, we see people that don't have water—any water to drink. If they do, they're scraping it from the worst places possible. But in some places, like where I'm at right now in Burundi, there seems to be an abundance of water. But the water is not safe.

>> My baby's name was Stella. She died earlier this year. Her whole body was swollen and when I got her to the hospital she died. She was vomiting and had diarrhea. Adults suffer from this but the kids suffer so much more than us.

RANDY: It was this water source where she would come and get the water every day in these jugs and take it back to her children. And it is this water source that took Stella's life.

>> It is very difficult to think about her. It is very painful for me. I wonder why I am still here. I wish I could die and join her.

RANDY: I don't want Jacqueline to go through this again. She has other children. She's doing all that she can. Are we doing all that we can? We can change this. We have the power. It is within our power to give them clean drinking water so that she doesn't get to the point where she wants to die.

That's why it is critical that we do something right now. You and I can do something. We can come in and we can put in a well in this village and they will have clean water. There are so many other villages just like this. So many other mothers that are experiencing the same pain that Jacqueline is feeling.

We want you to join us in reaching around the world to places like this and giving them clean,

pure, drinking water. Will you do that? Will you give life? Will you give Water for LIFE? When you do, you will be changing the lives of mothers like Jacqueline all over the world. Do it today.

Studio appeal:

RANDY: If we could go back in time and say, hey! Could you save Stella's life? I think every one of us would go, well, yeah! Tell us what we need to do. We'll do anything. I think that's in the nature of most people to go, yeah! We'd love to save that little girl's life.

You say, what will it take? Well, \$48 will help give clean drinking water to ten people like Stella and her family so they don't have to worry about waterborne diseases. I think most of us would be like yes! The reality is it is too late for Stella but it is not too late for so many more.

But the situation is urgent. \$48 for ten people, \$144 giving clean drinking water to 30 people. \$4800 on average for a complete well. Okay. I think the point is that we obey what Scripture says. When we see a need, we reach out in love. We give people what they need to live.

TAMMY: Exactly. Randy, here's the thing that you're talking about too, is that I don't have to carry the load all by myself. You don't have to carry the load all by yourself. We get to do it together. That's the beauty of it. You're not asking me to carry the load. I'm not asking you to carry the whole load. So whatever you can do today, it doesn't matter how small it is, you have to know that it will make an impact. Why? Because the next person will give and the next person will give and the next person. And when we bring it all together, we will make a difference with it. It will expand. It will multiply in Jesus' name. We'll see great things with it.

Listen. When I listen to that story I think about Jacqueline right now. I wonder where her life is right now. The thing is to me, it is not just another story, it is her story. It is their story. You have a story today just like Jacqueline has a story. Whatever it is that might be going on in your life right now that you're asking God for, he'll meet that need just as he will meet Jacqueline's need, and many other families today if we respond.

They might not have tomorrow but they have today in this moment. What will that look like? For \$48 -- \$48 today, if you can do that, it will provide water for ten right now today. For \$144, it will provide water for 30. And if you were in a place where you could give \$4800, guess what? You're going to give water to a lot of people today for the rest of their lives.

To me, that is something to celebrate! It can be done, many of us are in a position to do that. If you are today, that's what I would just say, don't hesitate, respond, give! Give!

RANDY: On average, each well will serve about a thousand people for about 70 years. Because these are deep wells, they're built well, built to last, and built to be a blessing. But look. It is not just about the good work and I think the good work is good, it is great, it is lifesaving! But it is about the way we go about it.

There are a lot of organizations that will do this work. And I applaud them all. Any time someone gets that clean drinking water, I say yes, thank you, Lord Jesus. But when we go in we don't just give them clean drinking water, we present the gospel. It is through our words, it is through our witness, it is through many of our partners, many of whom are also pastors in these countries. They stay there, they work with the people, they tell them why we're doing what we're doing. And that reason is to share the gospel of Jesus Christ in word and in deed.

So, as you consider this really good work, it is a good one, consider the fact that it is also what I like to call "a God work" because it is not just expressing God's love but we let them know we're there for one reason, Jesus Christ. It is an amazing thing and we want you to be a part of it today.

Announcer: Water! Earth's most abundant natural resource! Yet out of this abundance, only a tiny fraction is suitable for drinking. And suitable is a loose definition.

TAMMY: This is their only source of water right here. This is his only source of water. This is where they have to come every day, all the way down here to get their water. You can look around and see that it is very dirty and muddy. There are frogs all over that I actually see at the moment. You can see the contamination in it. You can see that there has got to be disease and illness with each sip that they take.

Announcer: While the problem here is serious, the solution is surprisingly simple, and it's already been implemented in this Central American village.

BETTY: This is a time when I don't mind watching them stand here and pour water over their head because I know it's good for them.

JAMES: This is a place with which we give great praise to God and gratitude. But we need to drill hundreds of wells like this all over the world. You can see, if you can't look at these children, look at their faces, look at how happy they are, and understand the importance of clean water, it becomes the center of life. Schools spring up. We want children to get an education and we want them to come and get healthy, clean drinking water.

TAMMY: I absolutely love seeing James and Betty and the vision that they've had for so many years! RANDY: Absolutely! And that's really what it is about. It is about bringing heaven to earth. Because the reality is when you see so many of these pictures, when you see children suffering, when you see graves that are far too short to be an adult, when you see mothers weeping, siblings weeping because they know they could be next, it is hell on earth. It is awful. It is the worst that this life has to offer.

And that's the beauty of coming in and saying, we're here in the name of Jesus. We're going to bring you a taste of heaven. In this case, it is through clean drinking water. And we're going to tell you about the water of life, metaphorically, our savior, and we demonstrate a love that oftentimes, they go, where do you come from? Why did you come so far? Who are you? Why would you do this for us? We get to tell them, this is the love of our savior in action. We contrast that hell on earth with a little bit of heaven.

Tammy, that's the only thing that keeps me going because you know how taxing it can be to be in these places and to see the pain and to see the heartache. But to know we're going to go back, we're going to talk to our viewers, they're going to respond to say I'm going to do what God puts on my heart today.

God's the one to measure that. Yeah, we have to use numbers to reach our goals but it really just comes down to hearing God's voice, obeying, acting on it. That's Water for LIFE right there.
