Week 24: SMF, Last week

James & Betty Robison

"Because of Your Faithfulness"

**Studio discussion:** 

**JAMES:** Well, I'm James Robison. Betty and I welcome you to *Life Today*. This is going to be

kind of an unusual week. Both of us are in our 80s. I have been married to this beautiful lady

for 62 years, and we dated for four years, so that means we've been together 66 years. If you

wonder about us dating those four years, you don't have to wonder if this little, beautiful, as I

told her when I met her, you're the purest girl God ever made. Stay that way! Don't ever

compromise, even if I get where I'm not so holy. Well, believe me, you don't have to worry. She

stayed so true. And what an example. By the way, no matter where you've been or what

decisions you've made or mistakes you've made, God is able to lift us beyond anything we ever

do in our failures.

But he's also able to give us strength. And he definitely gave this girl an abundance of strength

to live with me for 62 years. Think about this now. I've been preaching 64. I was preaching two

years before we got married. Was it probably the biggest shock in your life and the biggest

shock in everybody's lives in our church that the shyest kid on the planet would be called to

preach?

BETTY: Absolutely! Neither one of us were expecting that, especially you, I'm sure. I'll never

forget that Friday night. It was so, so, so special. I had seen to it that you were elected youth

pastor because we had a youth meeting going on. That meant you had to sit on the platform

every night with the preacher, and you had to introduce him. That was not something you

wanted to do. You were a little bit upset with me.

**JAMES:** I had to sit there and listen to all of it. I wasn't all excited about it.

**BETTY:** But I was just so wrapped up in church. I had been to church all my life and was so involved in it. I wanted you to experience that with me. So that's why I did that so you would know. But God did something even greater.

**JAMES:** I got to hearing so much of God's Word through Daniel. He was 16 at the time, and he would quote entire chapters in the Bible. It was just like a conversation. So, I began to read, and something happened to me that week. God told me he wanted me to be an evangelist. Now, here's the thing. I was incredibly shy, but the moment I began to speak to any group of individuals, there would be a power and a presence on me that was far beyond me, and it actually carried me. It amazed me as much as it amazed the people who were listening, and it amazed the people who knew me.

What I want to do in this particular journey with you is move into what would have to be the last part of our journey. If we live to be 100, we've lived 80% of our lives. We've had a wonderful journey, and I pray we have many, many more years. I pray that we share it together, sharing him, and fulfilling his kingdom purpose. Because that's the reason we live. It's the reason he wants us all to live as believers, and as his family. He wants us to live fulfilling his Kingdom purpose in this kingdom, because there'll be no enemy in the next one, there'll be nothing to overcome, no need to wear an armor. So, if we're going to fulfill his commission, we do it now. Betty and I are totally sold out to that. We have seen his will done all over the world. We believe that even greater than anything we've ever seen can take place now.

What I'd like to do is get you to go on a journey with us to just see that when God started using me, he was so amazing because people would then invite me to come and speak in their church, or even do a series of nights, which we called revivals. They would be eight days. But when I began to do them, crowds would come before the church doors would even open. Sometimes, they would be overflowing the church before the service started. So, we realized something significant was going on because there would be so many people coming to Christ. Betty, it was a very supernatural thing that people could see. I did hundreds and hundreds of crusades.

Betty, I actually was gone far more than I was at home. I've got to ask you this. We had a child pretty early, just a little over a year after we married, but did you feel that I was being taken from you? What was going on in your mind when I was going out preaching all the time?

**BETTY:** Well, actually, I was in awe watching God work in you. I didn't know. I just thought that was part of what God wanted you to do. It was! You know, to go out and to share your heart. James, I can remember in preparation -- and there is a preparation God puts us through, kind of like a training period. You were in a training period. I remember us on our dates you said, "Would you help me memorize scripture?" Because you didn't know, really, how to do that. So, on our dates, I would quote the scripture, tell him where it was, and he would quote it back to me just perfectly. I just thought that was part of God's plan to get his word deep down in James's heart, so it would come alive when he shared. And boy, did it!

But still, I was in awe watching God work in you. All the desire I had was to be a good wife, and to be a loving mother, and to make a home for you to come home to. That's all I cared about.

**JAMES:** Well, you did it! And it's still incredible. Now, think about this. I've been preaching for 64 years. We saw hundreds of thousands of people saved and even millions in our crusades. But not 10 million, which we saw many times in a year in our mission outreaches when God led me away from the crusade ministry full-time to actually go overseas and go to the Third World.

I want to talk to you about how God moved us in the direction that we were going. It was so obvious that God had put an anointing on my life. So, it was not hard to know that when someone said, we really feel led for you to come to our town or our county, which many of the crusades were countywide, almost all of them were citywide, and I would go in and I would just watch heaven come down, so to speak. So, we kept doing this. Betty, for 25 or 30 years, I did crusades. I was gone 250 to 300 days a year. We had Rhonda, and until she was school age, you could travel with me some. Our beautiful Rhonda, who would sing from the time she was four years old in our crusades, beautiful voice even now. But it was just a wonderful thing. And then when she had to go to school, things changed and I didn't get to see you. We were praying to

have another baby for five years. And you had a condition called endometriosis, which makes it hard to get pregnant. But they say it helps you, healthy if you get pregnant. So, we were all in. But she never did. And so, we prayed really hard and felt led to adopt. We adopted our son, Randy. I'm telling you what. When I came home from Tulsa, Oklahoma, where we had just broken the attendance record for the coliseum. Oral Roberts had come in and sat on a step because nobody would give him their seat, even though he was trying to -- he was telling them he wouldn't take their seat. He just sat down, and nobody could get him to move. But he had come to the last service. He and I became unusually good friends. But I came home from that crusade, and you picked me up at Love Field. I get in the car and there's that little boy. I remember you saying you were praying, "God, please let him like him. Please let him like him."

**BETTY:** Well, I'm not giving him back anyway. You're going to have to get use to him.

**JAMES:** Well, I loved that little boy. And our son Randy has got four children. He's about to have his third grandchild. It's just a beautiful thing. And then suddenly, something happened. This baby we've been trying to have, you found yourself pregnant when Randy was -- was he about three years old?

**BETTY:** He was three when Robin was born.

**JAMES:** What did you think about that when you were in the restaurant with us eating and you went to the bathroom? It looked like you had --.

**BETTY:** I was hemorrhaging a lot. I didn't know then that I was pregnant. I had not been to the doctor. Well, I had been to the doctor but he didn't get to see me that day. And so, I didn't know what was happening. So then, I did go to the doctor and he said, "You're very definitely pregnant." He said, "I can't tell how far along you are because of all the hemorrhaging that you had." But he said, "You seem to be healthy so let's walk through this day by day." And we did. And then she came that next November. God really blessed us. I thought, what a double

blessing! We got our son, we already had a beautiful little girl, five years old when Randy came along, and now we had another little girl. So, God, triple blessing!

JAMES: He really did bless our family. I want to just say to you, there's no question to have the kind of family relationship we had with me being gone way too much, all the pressure that's on someone that is as visible as I was, we believe that your prayers helped our family stay healthy and strong, and helped us stay close to God and close to one another. So we want to thank you for loving us and loving our family. Now we have more than 30 grandchildren when you count all the great grandchildren, and there are more coming! So, it's pretty amazing to have more than 30 grandchildren. We call them the grand and the great-grands. I told my grands you were great too. So we have nothing but great grandchildren. But it's been an amazing journey. It really has.

But, you know, something happened 35 years or so, in the ministry and crusades. God suddenly, Betty, sent me to Africa. Betty, it happened because of the power of prayer. The places that I went, I believe you prayed us there. I believe that you, praying for our family, kept us so focused on his voice that when we heard him, we moved. And after I had gone to South Africa, a missionary there asked me to go and see the starving of Africa. He said, "You think you've seen poverty? I want to show you poverty. I want to show you helpless people." He took me to Mozambique. Betty, there in Mozambique, we saw thousands of people buried. We saw one graveyard, Betty, where the first time we saw it there were 200 or 300 graves, and most of them were about like that. They were little babies and little children, very young children. Most of them under three, all of them under five. Betty, we went back there years later, and there was 10,000 or more buried. It was just unreal what starvation was doing. When I first went and saw it, if you remember, we were up in the northern part of Mozambique on the border of Malawi, and we were feeding hundreds and hundreds of little children, many of whom faced starvation. You and I sat down and were talking. A little boy, we gave people a porridge-like soup, a good, heavy soup mix that was literally prepared by the medical and scientific community to meet the needs in that area. They would bring tin cans. They'd bring whatever they could bring. Sometimes, a plastic bag that the soup would burn a hole through. It just would break your heart. There it goes in the dirt, and they would get down on their knees digging it out of the dirt.

This little boy walked up, had on a red shirt, and was holding a cup. I said, "You look like you like that." "Yah." "And is it really good?" "Yah." And the minute he said that, I said, "You are my little buddy from now on." Betty, that little buddy gave me a picture of all the little children that were just waiting for somebody to give them a love gift of life by feeding them. You heard our cry in behalf of the poor all over the Third World and we have been able, working with the missionaries, Betty. The thing that blessed us so much was, as surely as we were sent to the evangelism field in crusades, and as a family, we gave our lives to it, well, these missionaries were sent by God. They took their families and they planted themselves in the midst of that suffering. When I saw that, I said, if we get the food here, they're not going to leave them. And boy, they never did.

We met the most amazing people. But I've got to go one step further. The missionaries that went are amazing. They took their children and their families, and they planted their lives in the midst of death and suffering. They planted themselves in the middle of hell for heaven's sake. Boy, what a difference they made! I mean, they were sent. So, when we talk to you about helping, we knew that if we put the money in and we get the food there, we don't have to wonder if it's going to have oversight. That's been going on now for nearly 30 years. It has been the most amazing thing to see.

So, Betty, to all of our viewers, to all of you who are watching, you're the ones that made the outreach on the mission field and the crusades all over America and around the world, you made life possible by supporting Life Outreach, which was sharing life all over the world. We have seen so many millions of people saved. It's because of not just the faithfulness of those missionaries, but your faithfulness.

God, thank you from the bottom of our heart for everyone who's helped.

I think you know how much we mean that. You became the miracle in people's lives. I've told you every day, if you listen to me, you can become the answer to somebody's prayer. I've said to you something so many of you found to be true, "If you want your prayers answered, seek to

be an answer to somebody's prayers." Boy, is that a true statement! Do you know what else you've done? You have given them the miracle of life. I want to thank you for that from the bottom of my heart. I want to tell you that right now, we're in the last week of mission feeding: 350,000 that right now are in place. We found them. They know that we're bringing food. How long we can keep bringing it depends on you.

Would you right now make the largest gift you can, please, to help us? ### **Transition roll-in:** (Uncommon Graves)

**RANDY:** We arrived in this village this morning. We came here to see a malnutrition clinic. We didn't know that we would watch them carry out this little boy, place him in this hole in the ground, and bury him. It's a hard reality. But in places like this, where food is scarce, where malnutrition runs rampant, graves of two-year-olds are not uncommon.

We asked at the clinic what happened, and they told us that this child, a little boy about two years old, had been eating whatever they could find on the trees and the ground because they had no real food to eat. And as a result of the malnutrition and the wild food, this little boy suffered diarrhea, no doubt dehydration, I would assume. And he died today because of malnutrition. As a father, and now as a grandfather of two grandsons in this age range, not far, if someone could do something to save their lives, I would give anything to do whatever it took to save that child.

There are others right now on the verge of death. So close. We save that child, we see that child for who he or she is, which is the image of God. And will you say as a follower of Christ, or maybe just as someone who cares about other people, I want to do something. I'll do what I can. You can't come over here and save all the children, I understand. But we have people in place

right now who just want your support. We shouldn't bury children like this. So please do what God puts on your heart.

# Studio appeal:

**JAMES:** That could very well be another little buddy. I have no problem holding those little children because I wrap my heart around every one of them. And I know you do, Betty.

**BETTY:** Yeah, I do! I can never watch one of those spots without my heart being touched. We went back years later, and we went to a church that was birthed out of it, and a school that was birthed out of it, because we said, we'll feed at the school, and the school met at the church. We met these kids that have been going there now for years, going to school. They actually had clothes that were sent to them by people like you from all over the world. We fed them until they were healthy. They sang beautiful praise songs to Jesus. They were just so happy.

When we left, we went out and the pastor was a little, short guy, and he thanked us for all that had happened because of what we had done, we together, and how these children were totally changed. When we left, I looked back and he was crying. I asked Peter Pretorius, "Why do you think he's crying?" He said, "I don't know." He told the driver to turn around and go back. He turned around and went back and got out, and walked over to the pastor and said, "We noticed

you were crying when we left." He said, "Well, Peter, I was crying because we knew that now that the Robisons and their team had come and seen what's happened here and seen all these beautiful, healthy children, there would be no need to bring food anymore. Come back!" The little children are crying because they said, "We won't have any more help." I said, "Peter." I got out and I walked over and said, "We're never going to stop coming. We're going to continue to help these children grow up and help as many others like this, all over Africa and all over the world." That's what you've done.
