Week 34: SWFL - Last Week

Studio discussion:

JAMES: You know, it's a joy to welcome you to our show. I'm grinning because I've learned

how to pronounce a Czechoslovakian name. I told him I can't even say Czechoslovakia. But

Pokluda, Jonathan Pokluda; is that right?

JONATHAN: You nailed it.

JAMES: I nailed it. That's a miracle! See, miracles never cease. Your Story Has a Villain. Boy,

oh, boy! Identify spiritual warfare and learn how to defeat the deceiver. The liar. The divider.

The destroyer. The father of death. And we can, can't we, Jonathan?

JONATHAN: We absolutely can. Greater is He who is in us than he who is in the world.

JAMES: I'm telling you, the stage is set, in my opinion, for the greatest awakening in history.

Okay. I want you to tell us what you're doing. You have a great church in Waco. You have a

great ministry. I want everyone not only to be able to get this book, as a matter of fact, if you

can help us give somebody a drink of water, and you ask for it, we'll send it to you because we

want to bless you. Jonathan, tell us what you want us to hear today.

JONATHAN: One, I just want to thank you guys for having me here. This is amazing. I know

there are rulers of nations that have sat in this chair. And so I'm humbled to be here with both of

you. I was watching you backstage. You remind me so much of my amazing wife, too, and just

so delightful to sit here in front of you guys.

I moved, our family moved to Waco six years ago. And I don't have a charismatic background, a Pentecostal background, really, in coming to the faith, I didn't think much of the Holy Spirit or even the supernatural as embarrassing as that is. You know, they say, "Father, Son and Holy Bible," I took the Bible and I was just learning it, and I wanted to know everything the Word of God said. And when you would get to the demons, that would kind of, something was happening there, I don't really know much about that.

And six years ago, we moved to Waco, and I was preaching. I was like, there's a stronghold here. There's a unique spiritual battle being fought here, and I could feel it. I could tell it in my time with the Lord.

JAMES: You've got a religious university there. That's good stronghold for the enemy.

JONATHAN: There's a spirit of religion there, and I felt it upon me. I kept saying that in sermons, and people would say, "What do you mean by that, pastor? What do you mean?" And I said, "I don't know." So that sent me on a three-year research assignment where I just took everything in the scripture that it said about spiritual warfare, and I don't claim to be the smartest guy. And a lot of times, the Holy Spirit will teach me something before I can teach anybody else. And so I just sat there and said, "I want to really understand this. I want to understand everything God has told us about this."

You see right there, the enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy. But Jesus says, "I've come so that they might have life and have it to the fullest." I thought, you know, I want the abundant life, the full life that Jesus came here to offer us. I understand that my story has a villain. There's an enemy out there, or enemies who hate me, and they hate my children, and they hate my family, and they hate my marriage, and they hate our ministry. So what does it look like for us to defend ourselves against them? As I began to write that down as the Holy Spirit would download that to me through the Word of God, and I would put pen to paper, this book, *Your Story Has a Villain*.

JAMES: Don't you think it's really important for people to realize the enemy is a deceiver, but the enemy has a voice. In the spiritual realm, it's like, right now we're sitting in a studio. This studio is full of hundreds of voices from many different channels. You can tune a channel and hear those voices. Well, there are two major voices. There's the voice of life and the voice of death. There's the voice of truth and the voice of deception, and they both communicate, and you tune in.

The enemy is a master at capturing people's attention and capturing their ears and speaking words of deception. One of the most powerful things I learned about spiritual warfare is, all your thoughts are not your own. They are put there by a deceiver or by the voice of truth. You can recognize them and receive what they offer. And the enemy that deceives gives division, destruction, and death. He is the father not only of lies, but of death.

JONATHAN: He says we demolish all arguments and take every thought captive and make them obedient to Christ. So as you put on the spiritual armor, there's a reason that we start with the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, the feet fitted with the readiness of the gospel, the helmet of salvation, and the shield of faith, which extinguishes the fiery darts of the enemy and the sword of the spirit, which is the Word of God. We never stop praying. I think prayer is the key that opens the chest so that we can put on the armor.

But I want to go for a second to the shield of faith, because I think there's something really fascinating that happens here in the Word of God. I believe God is telling us something. So Paul writes this to the church in Ephesus, and he's probably chained to a Roman soldier and using this as an illustration of what it looks like to walk in the full spiritual armor.

JAMES: He says that shield will quench the fiery darts. Will not those fiery darts be fiery words of deception?

JONATHAN: That's right! The lies that the enemy tells us. He's a liar. He's constantly trying to deceive us. And so he says, what is the solution that's going to protect us from the enemy's

attacks? Its our faith. Our belief in God, like you said, tuning in to that voice. Because you've got two voices, you got competing voices. But tuning into, okay, Lord, I want to listen to you. And when my -- if my kids are lost in a mall or on the beach or anywhere, you know, and I'm like, Weston! Weston! Someone is saying, hey, look at this! Hey! Come here. Hey, little boy! Like Weston! Listen to the voice of the father.

So I want him to tune in to the voice of God. So this is my faith. Now, it's interesting. Paul says that to the church in Ephesus. But then Peter, Peter in First Peter five says, "Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him standing firm in the faith."

Here's that word again. *Faith* is our protection from Satan's attack. Now, if it was just Paul and just Peter, that would be interesting. But then in Luke 22, you have Jesus. And Jesus says to Peter, "Peter, Satan has asked me to sift you like wheat." To which I would be like, just say, no! Just tell him no, Jesus. Just say no. Make like an 80s drug campaign and just say no. You know? But he doesn't. He says, "So I will pray for you that your faith will not fail."

Now we see that word again three times. There's something to this idea that our trusting in the Father is our protection from the enemy's lies, from our protection from the enemy's attacks. So I really believe that he wants us, and you guys know this, he wants us to put our shield down. He does that through discouragement, through circumstances, maybe getting laid off, maybe a breakup, maybe a sickness, maybe the death of someone. What happens is when that...

JAMES: He uses deception but he also uses deception of distraction that take you away. And then distractions can be a magnificent attraction, can even be something that God made that is, in fact, beautiful but it is not to be an unhealthy attraction. It takes us away from the ability to hear the Father and to shield the darts of the enemy. Excuse me.

JONATHAN: No! It's perfect. You know, that car wreck or that bad news comes. What do we do? We had our shield up and we do go. Oh, no, oh no. We put our shield down and then he comes full force, boom, boom! Shooting you from every angle with the lies, with the

deception and the distraction. You know, one thing that these I see in the younger generation right now, the deconstruction, you know, they're just out there like, what do I believe about God? You know I'm not sure. I'm spiritual, but not religious, and really trying to look at every TikTok and Instagram reel trying to figure out their new faith, some new spirituality.

I think in those moments, we have to go back to what is true? What's the truth that I can stand on? Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one gets to the Father except through me." And so, we found the cornerstone. We found the strong foundation. We go back to the reality that God loved us so much that he gave his only Son that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. I have to preach that to myself every single day, returning to the gospel and just the love of God through His Son.

BETTY: I think one thing I've come to realize through years, a lot of years, 81 years of growing, and one of them came right before my 19th birthday, coming to know Jesus because of James' testimony. And just realizing, because I grew up in the Baptist church, I tried to be good all the time, but I did that because I was afraid of God. I didn't realize I had, after I got saved, I really had an armor I could put on and wear. I read it in the Bible, but I didn't think that was for me necessarily.

But when I realized that God gave us a defense, him, his armor to wear and put on, and we didn't have to allow the enemy to come in. A lot of those darts that he points at us are from the inside out. Like, I was so fearful. A lot of the things, somebody around me might not know that. I was intimidated.

JONATHAN: I saw in your book that you talked about that.

BETTY: I was intimidated, you know. And so, it wasn't necessarily material things that people would say, Oh, she's being attacked! I know about them, though. But until I realized we have a deliverer, and that's Jesus Christ, and I can stand against the enemy, yes! He will bring those thoughts of fear again, but I now know how to battle him, and I know how to stand. That makes a big difference.

JONATHAN: You don't have to be afraid. You do have to be aware. That's what I would just say to our viewers, you don't have to be afraid. Greater is he who is in you than he who is in the world.

But you do have to be aware that there is a spiritual battle all around you. You have a villain. You have an enemy that seeks to -- he wants to hinder your relationship with Jesus. He wants to push you to isolation. He wants to keep you from church. He wants to keep you from serving. He wants you to think that your neighbor is your enemy, or your boss, or your coworker. No, no, no! Our battle is not of flesh and blood. It's against spiritual beings. These are ancient, brilliant beings who have studied your family line for thousands of years. And they're crafty!

JAMES: Yes, they are. But you do not have to be deceived by them. If you know the word, you know his word, his word reveals the lies and the liar. I'm telling you, the beautiful thing is, is coming to hear the Father's voice so clearly that you know he never leaves you. And you can hear him. I honestly believe that we can develop a relationship with the Father that is very conversational. I don't want people to think that I'm exaggerating or making it up. But I'm telling you, I hear his whisper, I hear him talk, I hear him sometimes speak very forcefully. I always hear him speak with indescribable love and the deepest compassion, not only for me, but that compassion to flow through me toward others. And he's put it in me. I believe that he directs my thoughts, he directs my steps, he directs and redirects my desires, my attractions from distractions -- attraction to what he wants. Does that make sense?

JONATHAN: It does! I mean, he's always speaking. I think he wants us to hear him. He wants to be heard more than we desire to hear him. I want to go back to something I said early on. I'm so thankful for a church. I got saved here in Dallas at a church, and I'm so thankful for the ways that they taught me the Word of God and to esteem the Word of God. I'm sure it was my hard-headedness that was just missing the, okay, but the Spirit of God wants to speak to you. He wants to illuminate the things of God through the Word of God and the people of God. And I love that relationship that I believe marks your life. You are a man who walks with Jesus,

listening to the Father. What is it you want from -- where do you want me to go? What does faithfulness look like?

I think it's so important for our viewers to understand that you can't always determine obedience by the outcome, or even the preconceived outcome. Sometimes, when God wants to fight a giant, he raises up a boy with a slingshot who doesn't do things always in a way that makes the most sense to us and our logical pragmatism. Sometimes, he's like, hey, I want you to go share the gospel with that homeless person. Or I want you to go share the gospel with that executive in the corner office. And if he asks us to do it, we need to walk over there and say, hey, listen, I've got some good news for you.

You mentioned being at the precipice of a great awakening or the greatest awakening of our generation; I'm seeing it everywhere I go. If you have the gift of evangelism, I just want to encourage you with this. It seems to me that God has just swung open the hearts of men and women everywhere. Because I'm sharing the gospel with Uber drivers and servers and security guards, and everywhere I go talking about Jesus, and it just seems like people are really interested in that message. They're like, You mean I can live forever? You're telling me 2,025 years ago, this carpenter was born in Bethlehem and reset the calendar? And then lived in Nazareth and became the single most polarizing character in the history of history?

And people, whether they have an Islamic background or a Hindu background or Buddhist background, whatever it is, an atheist, you know, agnostic, they're like, yeah, tell me more about that. It's just a new day.

JAMES: He's alive, and God is using people right now you never would have dreamed he would use. I've spent my life pouring his life into people who had never heard what they need to hear. And you're seeing the effects of what he did in their lives through the truth shared. I mean, the unadulterated truth shared and unconditional love has changed them to where now they're in leadership circles, even in our national cabinet. I look out about-- God, I feel like I picked many of these people because I was sowing seeds in the lives of people who had leadership places and leadership ability, but they didn't understand the voice of wisdom and the

voice of truth. But when it was poured on them in love consistently, with deep conviction, nonstop, it began to change them. And now then, it is touching the whole world. We are seeing some positives.

I believe the stage is set for the greatest spiritual awakening in the history of the world. I believe that with all my heart. His will can be done on his earth. Can we just commit together that we will be trusting him for that? That we will be asking God to show us how we can help his followers and his family fulfill his dream on this earth. Can we agree to that?

JONATHAN: We can agree on that.

JAMES: Father, I thank you so much. I just think this guy is so full of you and I just pray you bless every single thing he does and bless him down there in Waco. I pray that university there will explode with your truth. Wouldn't that be something? If every church would explode with your love and your truth just flowing like a river of life; in Jesus' name.

Now that's a prayer we can all agree with. I want you to know that if you will help us give water to people who have never had clean water, just help us, and you'd like to have this book, and you ask for it, we'll send it to you, *Your Story Has a Villain*, and boy, does it ever. But we can walk over that villain like dust. Yeah, like a serpent you can crush, like a scorpion you can crush. We can do that. And we do it in this life because there's no enemy in the next one. So, let's become overcomers now.

We are drilling water wells; 350 is our goal. This is the first time that I've ever thought I might have to tell some of our missionaries we're not going to be able to put a well in your village. Please! I don't want to say that, but I'm telling you right now, we need a miracle in this last week of Water for Life. I need a miracle. Transitional roll-in: [Water is Life]

RANDY: Water. It is the essence of life itself. We all need it every day. But what if your only water source is deadly? That's the situation right here where I'm at in South Sudan and in many other places around the world. Their only source of water is contaminated, and it's killing them.

I have spoken to mothers in other countries who do not have access to clean water, and the result is devastating.

OPEN CAPTIONS: (Josiane) I think that so many deaths of the children in my village are caused by this dirty water because they all have the same sicknesses.

RANDY: This Cambodian family had recently buried two children who died from diseaseridden water.

Elizabeth, in South Sudan, told me her heartbreaking story of how they had no other choice but to give their children dirty water from the lake.

OPEN CAPTIONS: (Elizabeth) We have a lot of challenges with this water. For example, one of our five-year-olds has passed away. We feel this water gives us a lot of sicknesses.

RANDY: You and I can change that. We *have* changed it for many villages in various parts of the world. But there are many more that desperately need it. They are asking us. They are begging us, if you could just give us fresh, clean water, we wouldn't be so sick, we could take care of our families, we could live to see another day.

As we give Water for Life, we give life to so many people. And it starts with you.

JAMES: Betty, I just love those people. Randy said we've given so many. You know you've drilled eight, going over 8000. That's 8000 villages! And that's basically, as millions of people have been saved, and come to Christ. Right now, we have the first time that it looks like if we don't have a miracle this last week a response from everybody watching, and I've prayed a long time for everybody watching to give something. And James, as I was sitting here watching our son making a plea for water for these precious people, and their children especially, I sit here and thought, when we go into a restaurant, James, they'll always come up say, "What would you like to drink?" They'll name off all these different drinks. I'll always say, "Just water." It's not just water for them, it's life for them. It's so much more!
